From the GM'S DESK

IN the past few FUSION articles, I elaborated on the development and upgrading plans of the Club. This has been to update members on the Management's intention to rebrand Civil Service Club as a club of choice for public officers. Through our 3 Clubhouses, CSC provides a wide selection of quality facilities and activities to meet the diverse needs of our members. To achieve this, the Management will focus on four main areas.

Continually upgrade Club facilities

Good news: many improvements to the Tessensohn Clubhouse have now been completed! We have improved the accessibility of our parking facilities. With the new lift at Tessensohn Clubhouse up and running, members can now park their cars at the covered car park and use the respective lift lobbies to access their desired destination. Storage areas have been provided in each basement car park lobby for bowlers to store their bowling balls in the rental lockers. A dedicated car park lot which provides easy access to each lift lobby has also been reserved for those who may have mobility issues to park their car. Lighting in the car park has been replaced with LED lights and signage upgraded.

Our recreational facilities have also been given a facelift. The tennis courts have been painted and refurbished. The sound systems in the auditorium and the function rooms have also been upgraded to provide members with a better audio experience. Do visit the Clubhouse to experience its new look and feel firsthand.

Improve service standards

The Club has updated our Constitution and by-laws to improve the transparency of our operations and renew our commitment to providing members with excellent service offerings. The main changes that affect the members are highlighted on page 5 of the document. We will also invest in more staff training this FY to institute high service standards within the Club.

Organise stimulating activities

Some of the new and exciting activities which the Club will be rolling out include the COMIFEST that we are organising at Bukit Batok Clubhouse during the upcoming June holidays. This will be a 2-day extravaganza featuring a wide array of comic books to appeal to fans, both young and old. There will also be COS-Play Characters on parade for photography opportunities.

To give members something new to look forward to, there will be a themed activity each month. For June, parents might enjoy the parents' survival guide which offers a wide range of family-centric activities to encourage parent and child bonding. These include educational road trips to Malaysia for the entire family. Other activities throughout the year include wine and food pairing sessions at Changi Clubhouse, as well as a Civil Service Karaoke Competition with the preliminary rounds held between August and November 2011. Champions will be decided during our annual Civil Service Club Countdown Party, so get those vocal cords warmed up!

Enhance membership value

We are exploring various ways to enhance membership value. One such initiative is the recent Civil Service Club-PAssion Card (CSC-PA) partnership. The Club is giving a complimentary CSC-PA Card to all principal card members committing to a 2-year membership with the Club. Members need only carry this card to use the Club's facilities, enjoy its EZ-link facility and a wide range of discounts from the extensive retail outlets and trade merchants of both Passion Card and Civil Service Card. We are encouraged by members' positive response to this thus far. The CSC-PA Card will be issued to members in June 2011.

To further promote the Club as a truly family club, we have recently enabled principal card members to sign up for a supplementary card for their parents. This will allow a member's spouse, children and parents to easily enjoy the benefits of Club membership and is one of the ways that the Civil Service Club supports family togetherness.

To show our appreciation for members' support, members participating in the Club's social activities will now receive a 10% rebate voucher from the Club for every \$50 spent on such activities. This will be effective from 1 May 2011 and can be used to either off-set the cost of participating in future Club social activities or use of the Club's facilities.

BCA GREEN BUILDING CHALLENGE 2011



FOR the second consecutive year, the Civil Service Club was appointed to run the Green Building Challenge for Building Construction Authority (BCA). The event took place on Saturday, 2 April 11, in conjunction with the BCA's Green Building Exhibition.

Flagging off from Plaza Singapura, the 16 teams from various tertiary institutions were given clues to search for 3 Green Buildings: 313@Somerset, InnoVillage@ Singapore Polytechnic and the National Library.


At each location, the teams had to find and identify, with the help of clues, green features located in the buildings. They were also given tasks at different checkpoints – such as constructing a 50cm-tall windproof structure out of waste materials (empty cans, newspapers) – before they could move on to the next Green Buildings.

At the end of the race, when the top teams were asked what their winning formula was, "teamwork!" was their chorus, and not surprisingly so, as the participants agreed communication and coordination within the team made a big difference. Other vital factors they cited include reading up on green buildings and eco-friendly issues and technology beforehand, physical stamina, having a good strategy to minimize travelling time, and tapping on quick wits to decipher the clues given.

The event proved to be an educational experience in more than one way. The students learnt more about various buildings' energy-saving features and green technology – which they had previously not been aware of – and also had a chance to practice thinking on their feet, literally.

THE Civil Service Club held the STAR Games Award Presentation Ceremony on Tuesday, 22 March 11, to honour the sports achievements of the various government agencies and contributions made by the Club's games convenors and sports liaison officers.

More than 100 guests gathered at the Ruby Room of Club CSC @ Tessensohn for the yearly event and were treated to a sumptuous dinner. In his address, Guestof-Honour and Chairman, Board of Games, Mr Tan Boon Huat, announced that the participation rate in the 2010 STAR games had reached a new high of 12,438 which was 2.3% more than the 2009 figure of 12,157. He warmly congratulated and thanked the games convenors and sports liaison officers for their contributions and commitment in achieving the better results. He also congratulated Ministry of Education (MOE) for winning the coveted Division I Championship Trophy in 2010 and JTC Corporation for winning the Division II championship for the third time.
