### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### 1. The Event and Games

- 1.1 The Public Service Interactive Games 2023 (PSIG 2023) will be held in conjunction with the Public Service Sports and Family Day 2023 (PSSFD 2023).
- 1.2 The Public Service Interactive Games consists of three games. The tentative programme is shown in the Annex.
- 1.3 Participation is free of charge.

### 2. <u>Eligibility</u>

2.1 The PSIG is open only to civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, and employees of registered former Statutory Boards.

### 3. Entry and Registration

- 3.1 Teams must register through the Sports Liaison Officers/Co-ordinator of their respective organisations via the online portal. Only team registration shall be accepted. <u>Individual entries will not be accepted</u>.
- 3.2 Each STAR organisation is allowed to enter a maximum of five teams.
- 3.3 Each team shall comprise a minimum of 6 players and 4 reserves.
- 3.4 A team can comprise any combination of male and female players. However, team captains must ensure that their teams are able to field at least <u>2 female</u> players to play in any of the games.
- 3.5 Teams fielding ineligible players shall be disqualified from the event. Team members must produce their staff cards and Identity Card during random check or in event of protest.

### 4. Public Service Sports And Family Day (PSSFD) Tickets

- 4.1 Participants in the PSIG can also register their spouses, children and/or parents, to take in the activities at the PSSFD.
- 4.2 Only registered participants and family members will be issued with the PSSFD tickets for redemption of fun packs and freebies at the event.
- 4.3 Each participant shall be issued with only <u>one</u> PSSFD ticket regardless of the number of events that he or she take part in.
- 4.4 Participants must collect the PSSFD tickets from the co-ordinators of their respective agencies.
- 4.5 Participants must bring along their tickets on day of event as <u>no replacement</u> <u>tickets will be issued at the event</u>.

### 5. Interactive Games Format

- 5.1 The Interactive Games shall comprise three games.
  - a) Archery Tag
  - b) Bubble Soccer or Flip the squares game (TBC)
  - c) Giant Jenga Challenge or Bottle Flip Connect 4 (TBC)

Details of the three games will be revealed on event day.

- 5.2 The number of players for each game is six (6). Team Captain must include <u>at</u> least 2 female players to play.
- 5.3 Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 point for a loss.
- 5.4 The points from the three games will be aggregated to determine the top four teams.
- 5.5 A fun One Public Service game will be held after the three games. No points will be awarded for this game.

### 6. <u>Disqualification</u>

- 6.1 No points will be awarded to a team if it fails to:
  - a) report on time for the PSIG;
  - b) field the required number of players to play in a game;
  - c) include 2 female players in a game.

#### 7. <u>Team Manager and Captains</u>

- 7.1 Each participating agency must appoint a team manager.
- 7.2 The team manager must be report at the side of the main stage by 7.45am to receive the organisation flag from the Guest-of-Honour.
- 7.3 Each team must appoint a team captain who will be responsible for the conduct of the team members.

#### 8. <u>Prizes</u>

8.1 The prizes for the top 4 teams are as follows:

PLACING	Cash Prize
1st	\$350
2nd	\$300
3rd	\$250
4th	\$200

8.2 Team Captains of top 4 team must be present to collect the prizes from the Guestof-Honour at the main stage otherwise the prize will be forfeited.

### 9. Organisation T-shirt

9.1 Participants in a team are encouraged to wear their organisation's T-shirt or Tshirt of the same colour if they do not have an organisation T-shirt. This is to facilitate easy identification of the teams.

# 10. Organisation Flag

10.1 To enable supporters to identify their teams and also to enhance the carnival atmosphere, team members are encouraged to bring along their organisation flag on display in the field and at the area designated for their supporters.

# 11. <u>Protest</u>

- 11.1 Any protest must be submitted:
  - a) by the Team Manager/Captain,
  - b) in writing using the official Protest Form,
  - c) to the Organiser,
  - d) together with a deposit of \$50, and
  - e) within 10 minutes following the conclusion of the Interactive Game in dispute.
- 11.2 The Protest Committee shall comprise a staff from Civil Service Club and two Sports Liaison Officers/Team Captains not involved in the dispute.
- 11.3 The decision of the Protest Committee in any dispute is final and no correspondence will be entertained.
- 11.4 The whole team will be disqualified if any of its members confront any official or staff of the Organisers.

### 12 Personal Data Protection

12.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.

### 13 <u>Covid-19 Safe Management Measures</u>

- 13.1 All participating agencies and teams must comply with prevailing Covid-19 Safe Management Measures issued by Ministry of Health and Sport Singapore.
- 13.2 Participants are advised to exercise social responsibility. They must not show up at the event if feeling unwell or exhibit any symptoms of Covid-19 infections.

#### 14 <u>Rights</u>

14.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to revise the format, rules and regulations of the Telematch as and when deemed appropriate.

#### 15 <u>Disclaimer</u>

- 15.1 Participants take part in the PSIG at their own risk. Those with medical conditions are strongly advised to consult their doctors before taking part.
- 15.2 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the venue, date and/or time of the event at its discretion due to unforeseen circumstances.
- 15.3 The Civil Service Club, the Organising Committee, appointed contractors, sponsors, appointed officials and staff shall not be responsible for any mishap, injury or loss of life that may be suffered by participants and/or supporters before, during or after the event.
- 15.4 The Civil Service Club, the Organising Committee, appointed contractors, sponsors, appointed officials and staff shall not be responsible for any loss of personal belongings before, during or after the event.
