#### Renovation & Upgrading Works

Façade Upgrading – The façade upgrading and the building of the sheltered walkways were completed as scheduled. For those who don't drive and for mothers pushing their little ones by pram to the Clubhouse, the sheltered walkway will bring welcome relief, especially from the elements of the weather.

#### **Family Karaoke cum Lounge Upgrading**

– Renovation and upgrading work to the Family Karaoke cum Bar Lounge has started and will be completed by mid-August 2017. Once completed, members will experience a modern family entertainment set-up that they can enjoy with family and friends.

#### New Children's Indoor Playground -

The new children's playground and party room will be relocated to the 3rd level, next to the lift landing. The location is more convenient and conducive for children to have a fun time indoors. New sets of indoor playground furniture will be installed to provide a fresh experience for the children.

Swimming Pool Changing Rooms
Upgrading – Tenders have been initiated to upgrade the walkway and swimming pool changing rooms. This is a big project that involves the temporary closure of both the changing rooms to speed up construction work and minimise the inconvenience caused to our members. However, the pool will continue to operate during the construction period. Temporary toilets and bathing facilities, container style, will be arranged for the swimmers in the interim. Construction is scheduled to commence in July and will be completed by end October 2017.

**Tree House Walkway** – The walkway leading from the lift landing to the tree houses will be paved with interlocking tiles to enable users of the tree houses a

safer and pleasant stroll, especially at night. Work will commence in July and be completed by August 2017.

The construction of the sheltered drop off point will commence on 29 June 2017. Most of the work will be done off-site and so it will only take a couple of weeks for it to be completed. This will enhance the experience of the chalet users when they load or unload their things during inclement weather.

**Façade Upgrading** – We are upgrading the façade of CSC @ Tessensohn to transform the facade so it is befitting of a modern town club. Concurrently, the Clubhouse is due for a fresh coat of paint and this will be done in tandem with the façade upgrading.

**Solar Panel Installation** – As part of the Club's continued efforts to reduce our carbon footprint and save on our electricity consumption, we will be installing solar panels on the roof top of our badminton hall. Tenders will be called over the next 2 months and the solar panels installed by mid-January 2018.
