

ACTIVITIES OVER THE PAST FEW MONTHS

Renovation & Upgrading

CSC @ Bukit Batok

Re-zoning of facilities – The newly renovated family karaoke lounge, relocated from L3-Blk B to L3-Blk C, had its official opening on 20 Aug '17. It has 5 nicely refurbished private rooms, a big electronic darts and pool table hall, a comfortable common singing area and a well-furnished private room for those who want some peace and quiet while sipping their favourite whisky or wine. This is part of our plan to congregate the sports and entertainment segment to Blk C, and converting Blk B to a family area with F&B, art and craft, learning hub, children's indoor playground and kindergarten. The children's indoor playground and the party room will be fully renovated by the first week of Sep '17.

Swimming Pool Changing Rooms –

The renovation is in full swing and is expected to complete by mid-Nov '17. When completed, swimmers will be able to enjoy a full glass shower cubicle with rain shower and matching interiors throughout the bathroom. Even the walkway leading to the changing rooms will be refreshed with natural landscaping which culminates in a waterfall feature on one side of the walkway. We hope to provide swimmers with a complete therapeutic experience from their time in the pools even till they arrive in the changing room. The tender to upgrade the façade of the Clubhouse was closed on 17 Aug '17 and the evaluation committee will be evaluating the submissions. We are looking forward to some exciting proposals to transform the look and feel of the Clubhouse façade. As this is a major project, the renovation work will take between 8 to 10 months to complete. We will do it in phases so that inconvenience caused to our members will be minimised. Members will be progressively updated on the renovation work.

Thinking forward and giving a taste of what SG60 could look like with more car-free streets and cycle lanes, the City60 Bike-Run Challenge, taking place on 15 Oct '17, is the latest addition to the Singapore sporting scene.

With its main venue, start and finish line at the Singapore Sports Hub, the event is a modern and more inclusive version of what has been traditionally called a duathlon. Organised by MetaSport, the City60 Bike-Run Challenge, offers runners, cyclists, general exercisers and complete newbies a unique opportunity to experience multi-sport.

The race format consists of a run, followed by a bike ride and topped off by a second run. Four race distances are on offer; the City60, City30, City15 and City6. The number represents the total number of kilometers that participants run and cycle for each of the race distances. The City30, for example, is a 3.5km run followed by a 23km bike ride and another 3.5km run. Participants can do it alone or as part of a team relay of two or three members.

Athletes are treated to a high-quality bike course on totally closed roads. The bike ride course is designed to be safe and fast, taking place on a 11km circuit overseeing the city skyline. The first and second run follow the same route, allowing athletes to strategise and giving team mates the opportunity to compare times.

The Civil Service Club, loyal to its vision and mission of promoting a healthy lifestyle, has taken up the title sponsorship of the event. As part of the CSC contribution to the event, public officers and CSC members enjoy a 20% discount off their race entry and are ranked in a dedicated Public Service category. Teams of three showing their mettle on the City60 distance will be in contention for CSC Star Games points.



"The Civil Service Club has been actively organising major sporting events for public officers since its inception, so we are thrilled to be the title sponsor of this new exciting event" said Charlie Ng, General Manager of Civil Service Club.

Unlike other multi-sport events in Singapore that rank participants by age groups and reserve the shortest distances for the younger ages, the CSC City60 Bike-Run Challenge offers an entry-level distance for adults with little fitness base. Adults, as well as kids, can register for the City6, allowing family members and friends of different generations to share the same start line, bike and run experience.

To celebrate the launch of this new event, athletes are treated to generous perks and goodies, including a limited-edition t-shirt, bag and water bottle. Public officers can also enjoy two free training clinics by multisport market leader MetaSport. Event merchandise is also available in the form of hats and cycling jerseys.





RUNNING CLUB: FEATURING OUR MEMBERS

In this issue of the Fusion magazine, we take the opportunity to feature two of our Running Club members. One of them is the founding member of the Running Club, Paul Chan and the other is our current president, Abraham Chan. Both of them share a passion in running, which was the key reason that drove them to set up the Club and participate in the club's running activities regularly. We got them to share more about themselves...

Paul Chan is the immediate past president of the Civil Service Club (CSC) Running Club and the current president of CSC Cycling Club. He actively juggles between organising and leading various activities for the two clubs. 58-years-old Paul does not look his age as he leads an active lifestyle and would be a good role model in our initiative to promote active aging. We asked him how he got started in becoming the founding president of the CSC Running Club. To date, he has completed 16 full marathons and one 84 kilometres ultra-marathon. He further shared that running has made him physically fit and mentally alert and in developing him to be more determined in his work life and as a person.

Abraham, who has been a member of the CSC Running Club for four years, became the club's president in 2016. He started on running to stay healthy and joined the club to run with others who enjoyed running too. He added that since joining the club, he has made many friends and had fun being with them.

Both Paul and Abraham shared the many benefits Running Club membership offers. First, the CSC Running Club provides a supporting environment with both good and casual runners. Beginners and new Paul Chan leads an active lifestyle

members can start off by casual walking before progressing to running with some of our faster runners. Secondly, there is always fun and laughter in the Saturday runs through interaction with others besides participation in other activities such as CSC mass events, overseas trips, chalet stays and barbecues. Thirdly, the CSC is very generous in supporting the Running Club by sponsoring active members in participation of local running events. 


