For this financial year, the Club is set to transform its operating model... The Club will continue to evolve into a smart Club though continual IT infrastructure upgrades and embracing of smart technologies.

OVERVIEW

Welcome to the new Financial Year 2018/2019. For this financial year (FY), the Club is set to transform the operating model of the Club. The Club will maintain a sustainable budget by reducing the dependency on income from the fruit machine room and increase our revenue from all our other BUs. The Club will continue to evolve into a smart Club though continual IT infrastructure upgrades and embracing of smart technologies. Lastly, the Club will stay relevant to members and public service officers through promoting a balanced lifestyle with value-added services.

For this FY, the Club is expected to have a net cash budget deficit due to the termination of 33% of our current holdings of fruit machines from 1 November 2018. This will result to the closing of the fruit machine room in CSC @ Changi and a reduction in the number of fruit machines at the other two Clubhouses. The Club will need to transform its business model to cushion the impact of this financial deficit and yet stay relevant to members and public service officers. The business model of our BUs has been reviewed with an aim of remaining competitive and yet generate more revenue. All cost centres will be scrutinised to remain operationally efficient and yet with cost containment by harnessing the use of IT technology and automation

However, the Club will continue to invest in our CAPEX to refresh the Club and upgrade our facilities. Planet Bowl's pin

setting mechanism will be overhauled. The buildings at CSC @ Bukit Batok will be given a coat of new paint and the corridors on the 2nd and 3rd storey of CSC @ Tessensohn will be spruced up to complement the new façade that will be

completed by the last quarter of this FY. We look forward to have three renovated and upgraded Clubhouses by the end of this FY.

ALOHA CHALETS

The Club has taken over the management of the Aloha Chalets, (now renamed to CSC @ Loyang and CSC @ Changi II). Our focus is to provide chalets that are efficiently managed so chalet guests have a positive experience.

Booking System. The booking system now has a more user-friendly interface to view the location and types of chalets that they intend to book. To protect the user's booking data, the process is secured, where only members and public service officers who want to book the chalets will have their booking requests captured in the system. Those who are browsing through, will need to key in their request whenever they access the booking system. As the booking system adopted by the previous Managing Agent was different to that used by the Club, there was unfortunately an initial mismatch of data, resulting in some double bookings of the chalets. For those who visit the old booking website, they will be redirected to www.cscchalets.sg. For members and public service officers who encountered booking issues during this transition period, I would like to thank you for your patience and understanding. Do continue to provide us with your feedback and queries to chalets@csc.sq.

Enhancements. As part of our first wave of enhancements to the chalets, we have put in baby cots, baby high-chairs and childfriendly crockery to make the chalets more family-friendly. All the chalets have been installed with a digital safe, hair dryers, torchlights and umbrellas. The shuttle bus to commute chalet guests from one cluster of the chalets to another is in operation and those who are staying in CSC @ Loyang can now visit and use the facilities at CSC @ Changi by simply hopping onto the bus and vice versa. The Club has also partnered OBike to provide bike parks around all the three chalet clusters to convenience chalet guests who want to visit the neighbourhood. All the chalets are now WiFi-enabled and the speed will be upgraded to 200 Mbs by June 2018.

Coming enhancements. Soon, we will be introducing cable TV with sports, movies and kids channels to make the chalet stays more interesting and varied. Other enhancements such as bathroom amenities, coffee and tea dispenser for each chalet, buggies for ease of transportation within the cluster and a sea-sports centre in CSC @ Loyang will be phased in gradually.

New Staff. The Management would like to welcome staff who crossed over from Aloha Chalets to Civil Service Club. These staff are familiar with the operation of these chalets and have already been of great help to the Club during this transition stage.



With the integration of the three clusters of chalets, there are more facilities and activities that chalet guests can indulge in. So, do consider booking a holiday staycation during the coming June school holidays, at any one of the clusters of chalets and spend some quality time with your family without the fuss of travelling out of the country. To enhance your stay, the Club's Social Team will be organising some family themed programs at the chalets to keep the family engaged. Did You Know?

New MHA Rulings. The new MHA rulings on National Council on Problem Gambling (NCPG) for fruit machine (FM) will take effect from 1 May 2018. In compliance with the regulatory requirements, all members entering the FM room must sign a one-time consent form to allow the Club to check for NCPG Self-Exclusion. As mandated by the relevant authorities, members who do not wish to sign the one-time consent form will not be allowed to enter the FM Room.

New F&B Tenant. CSC @ Changi will have a new F&B operator to take over the place left vacant by the previous operator. LOTS Gourmet will be offering more F&B food options when they commence their operation in

late May 2018. They will be operating the poolside café as well as the restaurant previously occupied by Meyer House Restaurant. LOTS Gourmet currently runs a well-patronised outlet at Changi North, just opposite Changi Prison. The owner of LOTS Gourmet, Ms Jenny, will be the executive chef of the restaurant so there is plenty of tasty food, delicious ice cream and yummy deserts to expect from her eateries.

As MHA enjoys its achievement, Koh already has an eye on the next tournament. "I am encouraging all the teams to carry on participating in football games regularly to build on their teamwork and field fitness," he said.






