SPORTS ACTIVITIES

PS Sports and Family Day. As part of the Public Service Month, the Club organised the PS Sports and Family Day for members, public service officers and their families. It was held at Gardens By The Bay (Bay East) on 14 Jul 2018. The weather was good. More than 4,000 participants had an enjoyable morning. There was something for everyone at the carnival that featured a wide selection of activities – from fun and games, water and land sports, healthy life style offerings to fringe events. There was a CSR event, where members of our Cycling Interest Club cycled from CSC @ Changi I to the event venue to raise funds for the National Cancer Institute Singapore. Another fringe activity was the Amazing Race where participating Ministries competed to search for designated locations around the vicinity of Gardens by the Bay. The most important take-away from all these activities was the spirit of camaraderie and bonding of public service officers and their

City60 Bike-Run Challenge. Thank you for your registration for the duathlon event which will be held on 7 Oct 2018. The Club partnered MetaSport to enable our members and public service officers to participate in this premier bike-run challenge in the heart of the city, at great discount of 20% for public service officers while members get an additional 10% discount. If you missed registering for this year's event, there will be another one in 2019.

CSC Run By The Bay. This year, the CSC Run By The Bay takes on a new format of organising the run. It will be held at Gardens

By The Bay (Bay East) on 20 Oct 2018. Unlike previous years, where the run was organised in the wee hours of the morning, this



time round, it is going to be a sunset run. The CSC edition of the distance will be a 21.1km run, a 12.8km and a 6km fun run. There will be an Ekiden race for the 21.1 km and a race of 4 runners for the 12.8km. The race will cover iconic Singapore landscapes such as Marina Barrage, Gardens by the Bay, Marina Bay Sands, Singapore Flyer, the National Stadium and more. The venue will be transformed into a carnival with bazaar stalls, entertainment and healthy lifestyle workouts. Entries are still open for publics service officers who will enjoy an exclusive 20% discount and CSC members an additional 10% discount off their race entry in the event. CSC @ LOYANG AND CHANGI II (FORMER ALOHA CHALETS)

The Club has taken over the operation of the Aloha Chalets at Loyang and Changi since 1 Apr 2018. The Club took over at an opportune time when both clusters of the chalets had undergone a facelift and A&A upgrading. Together with the comprehensive handing and taking over of these chalets by the Club, most of the repairs had been rectified, leaving some minor repairs that the contractors are in the process of repairing. Most importantly, a new pool pump system, that filters the water in the swimming pool, has been replaced and the rough edges of the pool will soon be rectified. Other associate pool safety aids have been either replaced with new ones or more safety amenities have been added.

The Club believes in providing an enhanced experience for chalet guests rather than just providing chalets for them to stay. With the three clusters of chalets; Changi I, Changi II and Loyang, the Club has seamlessly integrated them, through our shuttle bus services, so that guests staying in one cluster can visit the other clusters. There are bicycle docking stations at each cluster. Beside the chalets, the Club will evolve different offerings so that the sum total of the facilities will enable the chalet guests to enjoy different experiences within a stone's throw of each other. For Loyang, the Club is creating a sea sports centre where guests can do sea sports activities such as canoeing, kayaking, bell boating etc. There will be a chillout lounge that offers BBQ food and ice-cold beers. There will be three sea fronting, dog-friendly corner chalets, set aside for guests to bring along their furry friends. These chalet occupants will have easy access to Pasir Ris Park and the beach. However, there will be stringent measures to ensure that other chalet guests will not be inconvenienced by the presence of these dogs. These new facilities will complement the existing facilities at Changi I, where there is a 20-lane bowling centre, a family karaoke lounge with private rooms, an infinity pool and great F&B outlets. Changi I is also located beside the food haunt of Changi Point, that has a wide range of popular local favourites.

The WiFi speed of all the chalets has

been upgraded from 60 MBPS to 200 MBPS. There will be cable TV for almost all the chalets instead of just the free TV programmes. Each room will be provided with thoughtful amenities for your convenience e.g. a mini safe, torchlight, umbrellas, mineral water, oven toaster, electric water kettle and even coffee maker dispenser. Toiletries will be provided such as toothpaste/brush and shower gel. Bath towels will also be provided too. The chalets are also children friendly. These improvements introduced by the Club will enhance the experience of the chalet guests at a relatively small cost.

As these are the initial improvements, the Club hopes that down the road more improvements can be introduced. The Club will be holding an open house on the 6 & 7 Oct 2018 to showcase what the Club has done. Those members and public service officers who are interested can visit CSC @ Loyang. There are ferry bus services to pick you up at Tampines and Pasir Ris MRT stations. Do check out CSC @ Changi website for the details of the ferry services. EXTERNAL SURVEY FY 17/18 - MEMBERS' SATISFACTION SURVEY FINDINGS

The Club conducts an annual survey to gauge members' satisfaction when they visit the Club, be it in terms of the touch points or quality of facilities and services rendered. Every alternate year, the Club engages an external research company to conduct a more comprehensive survey for the Club. The Club engaged a research firm to conduct such a survey with an increased survey base of 2,500 members, and public service officers.

Members' Satisfaction. The Club is happy to report that overall members' satisfaction has been at its all-time high over the past few external surveys, since 2013. The average mean score of 5.77, over a maximum score of 7. CSC @ Changi I was rated the highest with a score of 5.9. The most popular facilities across all Clubhouses were the swimming pool and the bowling centre. The highest satisfaction rated facilities, rated excellent by members, were the swimming pool and Changi I chalets. CSC @ Changi I continued to be the most popular Clubhouse that members would like to visit.

Information Platforms. Fusion! magazine continued to be the most popular information platform while the most preferred platform was email, showing a growing trend of members who are more tech-savy.

Mystery Shopper. The research company engaged 10 members of the public to conduct mystery shopping at the three Clubhouses. All received excellent ratings except for CSC @ Bukit Batok where the F&B experience was given an average rating.

Areas of improvement. There are two areas that the Club will work on. Firstly, to increase the number of F&B outlets in CSC

@ Bukit Batok. The Club is actively trying to engage a F&B operator to run a quality café that serves a fusion of local and western food. Secondly, to improve the social activities that the Club is organising. Although the Club organises about 80 social activities every month, there is a need to organise more interesting children's activities that suit the needs of our members and public service officers. Should members have any feedback on the type of social activities to organise that would be most helpful, and we welcome any suggestions. Please post your suggestions to either Samantha of the Social Department or through the feedback loop.





Changes elevate CSC Run by the Bay to new level

Amid Singapore's plethora of running races, the 2018 edition of the CSC Run by the Bay on October 20 looks set to stand out from the crowd thanks to the introduction of exciting changes, including a special bespoke option of 12.8km as one of the three distances on the race card, a move to a sunset start, and an exceptional goodie bag for all participants.

That 12.8km is highly meaningful. Introduced by the newly appointed event organizer MetaSport, it reflects the total distance of a spectacular waterfront course that follows the edge of the Marina Reservoir as a celebration of the Marina Reservoir' 10th anniversary and a reminder of the crucial role Marina Reservoir plays in helping Singapore achieve self-sufficiency in its water supply.

The emblematic course gives participants a bird's eye view of a string of Singapore icons, such as the Marina Barrage, Gardens by the Bay, Marina Bay Sands, Clifford Pier, the Merlion, the Esplanade, the Singapore Flyer, the F1 Pits complex, the Singapore National Stadium and more.

A standard half marathon of 21.1km is also offered for individuals and Ekiden relay teams of three, along with a non-competitive 6km run.

Running races usually only reward the best overall athletes, but with the mostly 10-year age bands of the CSC Run by the Bay, the chance of podium glory is opened much wider. And with the event being hosted by the Civil Service Club of Singapore, the field is further broken down into "public officer" and "general public" categories, so the 2018 CSC Run by the Bay promises to be the ultimate prize-fest.

The CSC is the home club of Singapore's public service officers and is the organising body for many sporting activities. Public officers enjoy an exclusive 20% discount and CSC members an additional 10% discount off their race entry in the event.

A cash prize fund of \$20,000 will reward the elite runners, and government agencies will be in contention for CSC Star Games points to be earned by teams of 4 in the 12.8km distance.

Even for those not winning a prize, the goodie bag is a reward in itself. Inside is a T-shirt or running singlet for participants to choose, a running backpack, a drink bottle and a personalised number bib. Live results and finisher's medals will be on hand too, and those completing the half marathon also receive a finisher's T-shirt.

This year, runners are offered the opportunity to raise funds for the event adopted charity, New Life Community Services (New Life), which aims to raise \$100,000 through the run. New Life is committed to serve the community and mentor the next generation regardless of race and religion. New Life conducts character mentoring programmes for children and youths. It also provides rehabilitation and reintegration for youths serving time in Reformative Training Centre, among other services.

The action does not end when the athletes cross the line, as the finish festival will be in full swing. Open to athletes and spectators, the festival offers kids activities, warm-up aerobics and Zumba, a DJ spinning cool tunes and the awards ceremonies, all taking place at a spectacular Gardens by the Bay East site overlooking the illuminated city skyline.
