Dear Members.



he Club has wasted no time in rolling out the CAPEX for FY 19/20 that will enhance the members' experience. Tender has been called for projects such as the gallery stand for the multi-purpose badminton hall at CSC @ Tessensohn, the upgrading of the fruit machine room and the construction of another function room, adjacent to the fruit machine room at CSC @ Bukit Batok. At CSC @ Changi I, all the instant water heaters in the chalets and villas will be upgraded to heat pump systems. Not only does this reduce electricity consumption, it enhances the bathing experience with a new complementary shower rose. Over the next 2 months, CSC @ Loyang will see upgrades to the children's indoor playroom cum party room and the function rooms. Lighted signage, both directional and to light up the chalet units, will be progressively installed in CSC @ Changi II. While completing these upgrades, the Club will do our best to minimise any inconveniences or disruptions.

Children's Easter Party. This event was held at CSC @ Bukit Batok on the morning of 21st Apr 2019. We were delighted to see the huge turnout of parents with their excited children. SPORTS ACTIVITIES

Healthy Lifestyle Walk. The March 2019 Healthy Lifestyle Walk was held at Labrador Park. The clear skies saw more than 200 members and public service officers turn up for the walk. This is one of a series of healthy lifestyle walks that the Club organises annually. More than 20 public service officers from Ministry of Communications and Information (MCI) participated for the first

time. They were there to support Ms Ratna Sari, CSC Executive Committee member, who flagged off the walk. We look forward to welcoming more MCI staff at our upcoming activities.

Sports Seminar. The Club organised the 2nd Annual Sports Seminar at CSC @ Tessensohn on 28th March 2019. The objective is for the Management to have an annual dialogue with the Sports Liaison Officers (SLOs) of the Public Service Agencies and to understand their needs and expectations. Constructive feedback was received during the dialogue. Many of them will be implemented and the SLOs will be updated as they are rolled out. MOE dethrones MINDEF in dramatic Badminton Tournament

The Multi-Purpose Hall at CSC @ Tessensohn was the venue for the Public Service Badminton Tournament 2019 held from 30 Jan to 15 Mar '19. A record number of 60 teams from 21 organisations took part in the event.

For almost a decade, the Ministry of Defence (MINDEF) had stood atop the podium at this annual tournament. After nine years, however, a new champion was crowned by the narrowest of margins. While MINDEF won two of the three championship categories - Men's Open and Men's Senior - the Ministry of Education (MOE) showed strength in numbers with a 1-2 finish in the Women's Open, second place in the Men's Open and third place in the Men's Senior to win the overall title by one point. The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and Ministry of Health (MOH) rounded out the overall positions in third and fourth place respectively.

Interestingly, MOE's Ms Lim Tien Juan shared that winning was secondary. "We participated without winning in mind. It was purely participation for fun. We sent in as many teams as there was a demand for."

The Ministry didn't have a special training regime either – again, fun was key here too.



"We all have varying hectic work schedules, and getting together to train was almost impossible," said Ms Lim. "We have gettogether 'play sessions' only a few times a year, just to get together, play and laugh together. Nothing too serious."

Not surprisingly, Ms Lim cited teamwork and camaraderie as being instrumental in MOE's success. "All of us turned up for the games together knowing some will not be playing that day. It's the once-a-year catch-up that we enjoyed, among friends," she said.

And as for MOE's plan to defend their title in 2020? Ms Lim shared that their victory won't change their approach. "No plan at all. Just do what we do best – play."

STAR Games Seminar


The Presentation Ceremony was preceded by the STAR Games Seminar, which took place at 2pm. It was the second of such a seminar, with the first one held in 2017. It was at the 2017 event that a slew of new initiatives were mooted. These included the introduction of:

- Cross-agency teams in non-championship STAR Games to facilitate the participation of smaller agencies
- Twitch in scoring system for 9-pin, 10-pin and 3-6-9 bowling events to encourage the participation of top management
 - Resource sharing whereby agencies with sports facilities could offer use of venues while visiting participants contribute refreshments, equipment etc.

Since then, such initiatives have taken off positively according to Mr Tan Boon Huat, Chairman Board of Games, in his opening address at this year's Seminar.









The good run continues. An inaugural game of Mixed Lawn Bowl was hosted on 23 February 2019 which attracted the participation of five teams from two agencies – not a bad showing for an inaugural game.

Next to address the audience was Guest Speaker, Mr Lai Chin Kwang, Chief ActiveSG of Sport Singapore, who shared on "Inspiring Better Life Through Sports". Mr Lai reiterated the agency's continuous support for CSC's sports programmes through a three-step approach: Awareness, Adoption and Advocacy.

More good news was in store for sports enthusiasts by the time the third speaker Mr Stefan Dahlgren, Founder of Valhall.Asia, took the stage. CSC will be the partnering venue for the Singapore Floorball Open 2019 in June. In addition, CSC @ Loyang will be offering its accommodation for the Floorball Summer Camp, where CSC @ Changi 1 and 2 chalets will serve as the official accommodation for the international teams and coaches. These regional speakers and subject matter experts will share their knowledge at the Sports Conference to be held at CSC @ Tessensohn's MICE facilities. The seminar proper followed and saw participants immersed in animated discussions in two breakout groups. Three main proposals emerged from the breakout sessions:

- To introduce two tiers of of competition: a top league for highly competitive teams and a lower one for those less competitive.
- To offer more learn-to-play leisure activities, instead of the current focus on competitive events.
- To create a sports portal for agencies to share advice and tips and pool resources and facilities.

Opined Mr Loh Tian Wei of Sport Singapore, "The engagement level was good. The session addressed concerns among sports-loving public service officers. The panel showed a willingness to listen to agencies and address difficulties. We have something to look forward to in terms of better game format, higher rate of participation and higher level of wellness among public servants."

Awards Presentation Ceremony

The best was saved to the last with the event ending on a high note with the presentation ceremony where 50 SLOs from 20 agencies received their Recognition Awards. A sumptuous 10-course dinner was also served at the Qian Xi Restaurant.

SLOs and CSC Games Convenors received their well-deserved recognition awards from Guest-of-Honour Mr Tan Boon Huat at the ceremony. Cash awards to the agencies that cliched the $5^{\rm th}$ to $10^{\rm th}$ placings in Division I and II were also given out at the event. Our heartiest congratulations to these agencies.

RIDE TO JAPANESE CEMETERY PARK (2018 RIDE) By Oei Su Cheok

There wasn't a tinge of eeriness when we rode into the cemetery park. It was well kept and evoked a sense of peace. It was a setting we have not seen elsewhere in Singapore.

The park was not too far from our usual meeting point at Lorong Halus Wetlands. Being out for our weekend ride, we did not head directly to our destination. Instead, CSC cyclists covered the distance around Seletar Aerospace circuit and toured Kampung Buangkok before arriving at our checkpoint for the day.

This checkpoint was the Japanese Cemetery Park at Yio Chu Kang. The uninitiated may only associate the imperial Japanese with atrocities of war. However, the establishment of the Japanese Cemetery Park was not to do with the war.

Instead, it was established in 1891 (before the war) by 3 brothel keepers for destitute Japanese prostitutes who breathed their last in Singapore but had no final resting place. The cemetery subsequently served the needs for a wider community of Japanese.

The Park at Yio Chu Kang is the largest and most well-preserved Japanese cemetery in Southeast Asia, with around 1000 graves. Nested within a residential area, the Park is not evident to people not seeking a visit. Nevertheless, it is open to all visitors and is a pleasant discovery for many of us on this ride.

SILKAIR MI 185 MEMORIAL (2018 RIDE) By Oei Su Cheok

Alas, more than 20 years have passed since the crash of Silkair MI 185 into Musi River in Pelambang. Memories of the tragedy have since faded, save this memorial which the airline erected in the Choa Chu Kang Cemetery in memory of 104 people who perished, considering that little of the victims' remains were recovered.

Our cyclists took this route-less-travelled to visit this simple memorial amidst the serene environment of the cemetery. It was a moment to reflect on the anguish of all affected parties as the investigation into the disaster could not find sufficient evidence to nail the cause of the crash.

Back on the cemetery paths, Richard applied his skill to fix a broken bike-chain. Surprisingly, we managed to ride home together! Fixing punctured tyres is no big deal but broken bike chain on the go is a new challenge. Camaraderie and fellowship was the spirit of the moment. Awesome! Grab-taxi might not answer a call from within the cemetery!

Further down the road, we touched base with National Shooting Centre, home ground to Singapore's gold medallists in international shooting competitions over the years, latest being the Commonwealth Games 2018. Security restrictions were tight. Regardless, we were within earshot of the winning shots (maybe).
