Dear Members,



As we are nearing the end of 2019, many of us are looking forward to a well-earned December holiday to recharge ourselves before we welcome 2020. As for the Club, December is one of our busiest months with a string of social activities, notably the Children's Holiday Programme, Children's Christmas Party and the Bicentennial Gala Night.

PDPA Compliance. Over the past 10 months, the Club was a hive of activities with infrastructure upgrades, organising the annual major sports and social activities, membership bulk purchase and most recently, trying to meet to the obligations of the PDPA. Previously, our membership card number was pegged to the NRIC number. In order to convert the NRIC number to a set of unique numbers for almost 65,000 members, the Club Management System needed to be updated, with the staff working over many weekends and having multiple discussions to ensure we meet the standard required by 1 Sep 2019. I must applaud the Membership and IT staff for their unfailing dedication and relentless effort to make it happen.

Membership Virtual Card. The virtual card that was introduced recently also went down well with our members. Many members downloaded the virtual card application and we noticed that there were many supplementary members opting for it as well. Under the virtual card, new supplementary members need not have to pay for the one-time application fee of \$10.

Swimming Pool Safety. The Club was in the news recently, regarding a drowning case that happened in Oct 2015. Many lessons have been learnt from this unfortunate incident, with the Club introducing many proactive measures to enhance the safety of the swimmers that are using our swimming pools. All children below the age of 12 and who cannot swim, are required to wear a pink wrist band and adults with medical problems (eg. epilepsy or heart problem) are advised to wear a green wrist band that will be issued at the swimming pool reception. This will facilitate the lifeguards to keep a closer look out for them. Children's shoulder floats will also be provided upon request. Parents are reminded to supervise their children when they are in the pool and lifeguards will make periodic reminder announcements. All our lifeguards are required to pass a mandatory basic life-saving test every 6 months and be familiar with the application of all the life-saving equipment available. The lifeguards also conduct quarterly mock up exercises of simulated drowning incidents to familiarise themselves with management of such incidents.

ACTIVITIES OVER THE PAST 2 MONTHS

Social Activities. The main highlight of the social activities held was the Mid-Autumn Celebration at CSC @ Bukit Batok on 13 Sep 2019. This event attracted a record turnout of about 350 members and their families. 23 seniors from the Lion Befrienders were also invited to share the joy of this festival. The weather

was good and the participants had a great time soaking in the stage performances held at the swimming pool complex, munching on moon cakes and enjoying the interesting night lantern walk around the pool complex.

The Halloween Fun Party for children that was held at CSC @ Changi I, Poolside Café on 19 Oct 2019, saw 43 fun loving children coming forward to



participate. The participants donned creative

costumes, coming as Pennywise the Evil Clown, Casper the friendly ghost, Darth Vader, Super Mario Brothers and many more at the party. The children had a great time enjoying the yummy refreshments and ice cream, face painting, exciting magic show and Trick-or-Treating at the chalets. All the happy kids returned with their pumpkin pots filled with candies. The two best dressed winners walked home with book vouchers. We would like to thank the parents for putting in so much effort to dress up their children and make this Halloween party a fun and joyful one.

Sports Activities. The CSC Run by the Bay held at Garden By The Bay (Bay East) on 12 Oct 2019, saw a record turnout of about 3,800 participants. It was a dusk run and all the participants enjoyed the cool night run. We had the honour of our Vice President, Mr Chew Hock Yong flagging off the 21.1KM and the Children's 1.28KM Run. From the feedback obtained from social media and directly from the participants, most were pleased with the event. To all runners, thank you for your support and we look forward to an even better turnout next year.

RENOVATION & UPGRADING

At CSC @ Bukit Batok, the upgrading of the FM room with toilet facilities was completed as planned, along with the common toilets outside the FM room. For the empty space outside the FM room, a new Jasmine function room has been built. At Blk A, level 3, a new shelter has been built over the open linkway to facilitate movement during inclement weather. All these will enhance the experience of our members when they use the Clubhouse facilities.

At Changi Clubhouse, the upgrading of the directional and chalet unit signage at Aloha Changi II has been completed. The

lighted signage will greatly facilitate wayfinding by chalet quests at night. The upgrading of the

indoor children's playroom at Loyang is ready for use. There will be a creative play area, reading area and an activity area for the children to have a good time.

SPORTING ACTIVITIES

The Club winds down its organised sporting activities in December so that our members and public service officers can spend more time with their families during the long December school holiday.

However, from 26 Nov to 4 Dec 2019, the CSC Cycling Interest Club will be travelling to Taiwan for their annual cycling pilgrimage. 17 Cyclists will be departing to Taiwan for their 7th cycling trip. The 9D8N cycling trip will start from Taoyuan, cycling up to the Central Range Mountain to conquer Wuling, at an altitude of 3215 metres. Thereafter, they will cycle towards the East Coast, to the Southern tip of Taiwan and end in Kaohsiung City on the West Coast, covering a total distance of 848 km. They will be wearing the CSC cycling jerseys during the cycling trip. The Club wishes them well and safe travels!

RENOVATION & UPGRADING

CSC Chalets

CSC @ Loyang. The units will be progressively refurnished to provide a fresh experience to chalet guests. Sea View Bungalow will be the first to be refurnished, followed by the poolside chalets and Garden Bungalows. The furnishing will be themed based on the bungalow clusters. The signage at Loyang will also be upgraded to improve wayfinding at night. Our dog-friendly chalets continue to be very popular for guests who want to spend quality time with their pets. We have recently equipped the units with hair dryer for their furry friends to use.

CSC @ Changi II. The Club is planning to introduce keyless entry to Changi II chalets using your smart mobile phone. This will facilitate the chalet users' ease of checking in to the allotted chalets without needing to go to the reception counter. E-keys can be assigned by the chalet guests to his family members or friends. Any additional services required, after check in, can be requested through pressing the appropriate icon in the App provided. We hope to introduce this before the end of this FY. Progressively, this will be introduced to Loyang and Changi I.

Changi I. After operating the chalets at Changi I for more than 5 years, the Club is upgrading the staying experience with better quality bedlinens, pillows, towels and toiletries. These will be progressively introduced from Jan 2020. At the same time, after attaining the GreenMark Gold in 2019, we are making a conscientious effort to make CSC @ Changi more environmentally friendly. All the chalet units use heat pump water heaters which cut down the use of electricity for showering by about 50%. Water dispenser units that dispense hot and cold water have been progressively installed in the chalet units. With this, bottled water will not be issued to Villa users. Eventually, all the chalet units in Changi I will be installed with water dispensers to save the use of plastic bottles and cut down the carbon footprint.



CSC @ Tessensohn Façade Upgrading. The renovation work commences in Oct 2019 and will be completed in early Sep 2020. In the meantime, the main entrance to the Club will be hoarded and access will only be through the car park entrance. Ease of movement to the various facilities will be affected and we seek your understanding. The renovation and painting will be done in phases so that access to the facilities can be available for use as early as possible. The first phase will be to upgrade the swimming pool alfresco dining area and the installation of a new lift. This will be followed by the renovation of the frontal façade and the creation of a new car drop-off and pick-up point.
