### Hello from the CE

Dear members,

Time passes really fast and 2019 is now another colourful chapter of our history. We welcome 2020 with new aspirations and hope for a better year for everyone. I would like to take this opportunity to wish our readers and their family good health, happiness and success in 2020.

2019 was a challenging year for the Club. We had to overcome the slower business growth in all our KPIs. We met these challenges through promotions, improved event organisation and new ways of doing things to generate more bookings and better utilisation of our chalets, bowling and facilities rental. The cutting down of 37 fruit machines, between November 2018 and November 2019, further impacted the bottom line of the Club. Despite these challenges, the Club continued to upgrade the Club, focusing on the Clubhouses' key main attractions and investing in eco-friendly devices and sensors to cut down the carbon footprint of the Club.

We introduced the membership bulk purchase for government agencies and a number of agencies (Singapore Customs, MOM, MSF, AGD, IHIS and NYC) have come on board to participate. Our membership has grown from about 50,000 to more than 65,000. The Club also combed through the operating costs, to cut down the cost of running the Club. The Club continued to harness IT to increase efficiency and productivity and enhance the engagement experience of our members and public service officers. One of the biggest challenges in 2019 was the conversion of our membership data to comply with the obligations of the PDPA by 1 September 2019. Staff were sent for PDPA courses, data in our CMS was reconfigured and all applications for membership, social and sport activities and chalet bookings were reformatted.

Though 2019 was challenging, the Club was able to manage the bottom line within the budget. The capital expenditure (CAPEX) was executed as planned, with the key focus on upgrading the facilities offered in CSC @ Bukit Batok. The façade upgrading at CSC @ Tessensohn commenced and is targeted for completion by August 2020 (details of the façade are on page 23). As for the focus at CSC @ Changi, it was to enhance the experience of the chalet guests through the installation of more eco-friendly devices in the chalets, installation of more CCTVs to enhance security and provision of lighted signage to improve the way finding of the

The plan to build a sheltered tennis court in CSC @ Tessensohn was shelved.
This is due to the very high building and GFA costs that the Club needs to pay.
The unexpended CAPEX will be channelled to other upgrades that we planned for the next financial year and which we will bring forward to this financial year.

The Social and Sports activities saw an increase in participation from both member's and public service officers. The Club will

continue to source for new social activities and use data analytics to improve the way we manage the current activities. The Club organised its maiden public service E-Gaming in

November 2019. The participation from the various public service agencies was encouraging. As such, we intend to make E-Gaming one of our competitive STAR games.

#### SOCIAL ACTIVITIES OVER THE NEXT FEW MONTHS

Lunar New Year Bazaar. Over the next few months, the Club will be organising a number of Lunar New Year festive activities. The Lunar New Year Bazaar will be held at CSC @ Tessensohn on 11 January 2020. There will be a host of festive activities lined up for the visitors ranging from Lunar New Year goodies, free snacks, cooking demonstration, feng shui talk and movie screening. There are also fun children's activities. There will be a members' festive draw with the top prize of \$\$6,888.

Each member will be given an attractive goodie bag, while stocks last. All these festive activities, snacks and goodie bags are free for members that are attending. Please see details on pages 6 &7.

to enhance the experience of poolside younger swimmers.

CSC @ Tessensohn. The poolside upgrading at CSC @ Tessensohn will be completed by end March 2020 with the installation of a

lift to the sheltered alfresco dining area. All the information signage will be digitised, resulting in saving of man hour costs and hard copy posters. The back end of level 4 will be

air-conditioned to maximise the usage of the seminar rooms. The Club will install the 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of the retractable gallery chairs in the multi-purpose hall.

CSC @ Changi. CSC @ Loyang which completed the refurnishing of one of the sea view bungalows, had received very encouraging feedback from the chalet guests staving in the bungalow. The rest of the 6 sea view bungalows will be progressively refurnished. This is part of the plan to thematic upgrade the furnishing of the Loyang cluster of chalets. The Clubhouse will be introducing Keyless entry to Changi II cluster of chalets where chalet guests using their handphone can gain access to their chalets. This initiative will not only facilitate the management in administering the guest check-in and check-out but more importantly, facilitate the chalet guests to seamlessly check-in and check-out and even E-send the key to their friends who are using the chalet.
