

## Hello from the CE

Dear Members.

By now, everyone is familiar with COVID-19. This pandemic has affected us socially, economically and psychologically. The number of people infected by the COVID-19 is not abating but increasing. Travel plans for the coming school holidays are held in abeyance and perhaps all of us are unsure when this pandemic will be over.

The Club is also affected by the COVID-19. Our two clusters of chalets at Loyang and Aloha Changi were consecutively activated as Government Quarantine Facility (GQF), during the Lunar New Year. Many members' bookings were affected by this activation. We thank our members for their patience with the inconvenience to support the broader national needs. We unfortunately needed to give short notice to vacate chalets or cancel bookings, as we were only given 48 hours to turn around the chalets to receive the incoming people under quarantine (PUQ).

We took in two flights of Singaporeans and permanent residents from the epicentre, Wuhan and housed them in our chalets. We are indeed proud to be part of the national effort to contain the spread of COVID-19. The operation was smooth and out of the more than 200 PUOs, who staved for 14 days, only one had shown positive symptoms of COVID-19. They have all since gone home and the chalets have undergone thorough cleaning. sanitisation and airing. While we are still prepared for a new batch of PUOs to be housed in our chalets if need be. I would like to reassure all members that our involvement as a GQF has not compromised the general safety of members. Our frontline staff and the management staff of CSC @ Changi had done a great job in operating and servicing the PUQs. Most of the PUQs were very happy with their stay.

For the Club, we have stepped up our measures of temperature screening and contact tracing at entry points. These cause inconvenience to our members and patrons visiting the Club. However, these measures have been well received by our members and patrons of the Club who are glad that we stepped up such proactive measures to enhance their well-being when they visit the Club.

We have also increased the frequency of environmental cleaning in the Club especially at all the likely touchpoints. Staff are also on the lookout for any member/patron who shows sign of any flu symptoms by offering a face mask and advice to see a doctor immediately.

All staff are required to do temperature screening twice a day. We have drawn out a clear SOP to manage COVID-19 and a Business Continuity Plan. All our social and sporting activities have been scrutinised and reviewed. with a number of these activities either cancelled or postponed. For members who were inconvenienced due to the cancellation of either the Social or Sport activities/events, please accept our apologies. We have also allowed civil service agencies and corporates to cancel or postpone their planned events, with no penalties. All these will have a knock-on impact on our bottomline and we can only hope that when the pandemic is over, the pent-up demand will pick up and minimise our loss in income, due to COVID-19.

As a Club, how did we perform in FY19/20? Despite the reduction of another 15 fruit machines in Nov '19 and the financial impact of COVID-19 over the last two months (Feb. and Mar '20), the Club performed better than what was budgeted. We trimmed our operation cost and improved on the KPIs of a number of business units. Our membership is increasing with our membership bulk purchase initiatives. The slew of promotions and upgrading to our chalets has also resulted in a better return of the chalet operations. All the CAPEX planned for this FY, except for the sheltered tennis court, were executed as planned. The sheltered tennis court was too costly to build and with a hefty monthly recurring cost, has made it non-viable. The roof top solar panel at CSC @ Tessensohn will be built in conjunction with the façade upgrading which will be delayed by three months due to COVID-19 i.e. by end of Dec '20. Likewise, the repainting of the Clubhouse will be done in tandem with the façade upgrading. So, by the end of this year, we will have a revitalised and modern CSC @ Tessensohn.



#### SOCIAL ACTIVITIES OVER THE NEXT FEW MONTHS.

The Club is mindful of the measures to minimise the spread of COVID-19. As such, the social events we will be conducting over the next few months will take them into consideration, such as hygiene factors, temperature screening, contact tracing and social distancing. As an illustration, the Mother's Day lunch Celebration will be held at CSC @ Tessensohn, Diamond Ballroom on 10 May '20, with a maximum of 40 tables of 6 pax per table and all the pre-event and stage games will be organised with social distancing being considered. The serving staff will be wearing face masks when they serve the food. The food will either be individually served or with common cutlery to dish out the food. Likewise, for Father's Day, the same proactive measures will be taken. It will be held at the Diamond Ballroom on 21 Jun '20 between 12pm and 2pm pm. (Please refer to page 5 for the detailed highlights of both activities).

Social activities for the June Holiday:

With COVID-19, many families are putting their travelling plan on hold in the June Holiday. The Club has lined up many social activities to enable the family to bond together. The activities range from baking, learning journey, to science and math busters, outdoor physical activities and bowling. There are also culinary, health and wellbeing activities for the adults. (Do check out the myriad of activities from pages 35 to 64. I am sure you will be able to sign up a couple of activities either for yourself or with your family).

International Yoga Day: The Club is partnering Vyasa Yoga to celebrate the International Day of Yoga at all our Clubhouses on 21 Jun '20. Attendance is free and again the same hygiene measures and social distancing of the participants will be taken into consideration. (Please see detail on page 6).





#### SPORTS ACTIVITIES

#### **STAR Games Awards:**

Congratulations to the winning Ministries for the annual STAR Games Competition for 2019. Ministry of Defence, MINDEF, emerged as the champion for Division 1. This is the first time that MINDEF has won the title, since the inauguration of the STAR Games series. Singapore Republic Polytechnic edged out JTC Corporation to emerge as the champion for the Division 2.

The Public Service Beach Games will be postponed to Oct '20 due to COVID-19.

Public Service Sports & Family Day: This event will be postponed to Oct '20 due to COVID-19. Once we have firmed up on the date, venue and programme, we will update members in the next issue of Fusion magazine.

#### **RENOVATION & UPGRADING**

Over the next three months, all three Clubhouses will be undergoing some renovation and upgrading.

csc @ Tessensohn: The façade upgrading of the pool alfresco dining area, above the pump room will be completed by May '20. It will be mobility-friendly with a lift installed and the area sheltered. A new sound system will be installed. The pool sheltered area with a retractable awning will be replaced with a permanent awning that will provide more shade and enhance the look and feel of the swimming pool. These are part of the plans to modernise and convert the pool area to one that is more family-themed.

Members visiting the Clubhouse will soon experience information mainly displayed on TV monitors. The Clubhouse will digitise all the information of the events and activities in the Clubhouse through a digital network using TV monitors to display the information. This will be more effective, economical and manhour saving. Also, we are installing advertisement and information display monitors in the changing room to reach out to our members and patrons.

csc @ Bukit Batok: In the repainting of the Clubhouse in FY19/20, the carpark flooring was omitted. It will be repainted over the next few months with accident prone junctions given a different

shade of colour. The repainting work may inconvenience the motorists using the carpark facilities, so please bear with us when the repainting work starts.

The swimming pool complex has some new additions to provide convenience to the swimmers and to improve the look and feel of the pool. There will be progressively five daybeds added to the pool furniture. From the swimmers' feedback, the daybeds are very popular with swimmers, that come with their family. We have also introduced some squirrels among the many trees around the swimming pool, do look out for them. Do note that these movable properties belong to the Clubhouse and cannot be moved or taken home.

CSC @ Changi: A new extension to the main office at Block E will be built to house more administrative staff. Once completed, the current reception office will be shifted to the new extension. The chalet reception office and the main reception office will be integrated to form a clubhouse reception area. This will result in manpower savings and yet provide greater efficiency to service both the chalet guests and members. The new extension will be built by Jul '20.

Due to COVID-19, the Keyless Entry to Changi II has been delayed as Changi II is being used as a GQF. During the lull period when there is no PUQ, ground work such as the laying of cables will be done and we hope to complete the installation of the Keyless Entry, once the GQF is lifted. In the meantime, the lighted signage at Changi II and Loyang will be completed by mid-Apr '20.

The refurnishing of the Loyang cluster of chalets is delayed due to COVID-19. The plan is to refurnish the seven seaview bungalows first then followed by the other bungalows. The new furniture will be shipped in once the GQF is lifted. We have good reviews of the first set of seaview bungalow furnishing that we installed, prior to the GQF.

Upgrading of Changi I: As part of the continual rejuvenation of Changi I, we will be reviewing the furnishing of the chalets and villas. For a start, Changi I will be launching its own line of room amenities in June, that is specially designed for Changi I cluster of chalets. The function room will also be renovated and upgraded with new AV equipment, digital flip charts and interactive screens.

#### INTERNET ENHANCEMENT

Clubhouse Website: The revamped website is mobile-responsive and will have the latest news and happenings on the homepage. The refreshed design is more user friendly for members to check the various facilities of the clubhouse.

Membership Portal: The Club is also revamping the Membership Portal. It will be integrating all the membership application, renewal and replacement in the portal. Members can use this portal to book facilities, events and rooms and make payments online. Members do not have to logout and login again to access the various modules. Other features include special promotions for members and is integrated with the CSC App. This project will be completed by end May '20.

Cashless Payment: In Apr '20, the Club will be implementing the SGQR as another cashless payment option at all our Clubhouses. Members will only need to scan the QR code within the SGQR label and make payment using their mobile smart phone.





# STAR GAMES AWARDS

On 28 December 2019 at the CSC's Annual Dinner and Dance, the top four government agencies in Division I and II of the Public Service STAR Games, received their well-deserved trophies from Guest-of-Honour Mr Leo Yip, Head of Civil Service and President, CSC.

The annual STAR Games is a key activity organised by the Civil Service Club for all public service officers. STAR, an acronym for "Staff Team up for Active Sports and Recreation" aims to promote a healthy lifestyle in the public service as well as to foster camaraderie amongst public service officers. Agencies compete in two divisions ie

Division I and Division II based on their staff strength. This year's 22 Championship STAR Games were competed by 37 ministries, departments and statutory boards representing all government agencies in Singapore.

#### **Division I Champion Ministry of Defence**

Taking the Overall Champion title in Division I was Ministry of Defence (MINDEF). The victory was exceptionally sweet and fulfilling as this is the first time the Ministry has won the title, since the start of the STAR Games series. Games which powered the agencies to the top spots are swimming, golf, darts, bowling, badminton, table-tennis and basketball.

MINDEF spokesperson for the occasion, LTC Joey Wong credited the win to its team of highly committed staff and team managers who successfully struck a balance between work and training. LTC Wong said that the agency is determined to defend the title next year by training doubly hard.

#### **Division II Champion Republic Polytechnic**

Meanwhile, the Division II Challenge Trophy went to Republic Polytechnic (RP). The agency edged out JTC Corporation, its main rival, to clinch the top spot. Receiving the award from the Guest-of-Honour, was Ms Tan Geok Hui, Director of HR Department.

"The strategy was to get more staff to be more active in more events, such as the Step Challenge, to gain participation points" Ms. Tan said. This had contributed to the total number of points which helped the agency to win the title.

Ms Tan noted that the STAR Games is a good platform for staff to interact and foster teambuilding, while promoting a healthier lifestyle. She, herself, had participated in the CSC Run By the Bay and found it to be very fun. She reiterated that the agency would want to keep the number one spot next year and hopefully, keep the Challenge trophy by winning the title 3 years in a row.

#### MIXED NETBALL | 18 JAN '20 Pasir Ris Sports Hall

This year's Public Service Mixed Netball Tournament held at the Pasir Ris Sports Centre on 18 Jan '20, saw 20 teams from 11 government agencies vying for the championship title. After several rounds of matches, the contention for the top spot was between Sports Singapore and Ministry of Defence. The match was fast and furious as both teams were equally determined to claim the title. In the end, it was a last-minute decider score from Sport Singapore's team, just before the final whistle, to win their maiden championship.

"There were several nerve-wracking moments where we were down by a point or two, but every team member held their cool, gave their 110% and turned the tables around," said Sport Singapore's netball convenor Gina Tan. "The most memorable moment during the tournament would be in the final: Our shooter puts up the shot, the whistle goes and we are announced the winner!"

And what was the secret to their success? "We managed to find the sweet spot by playing every individual player to their strength. Besides the competitive element, participating in tournaments allows us to stay fit and healthy, bond with colleagues and make new friends from other agencies through a social setting," said Gina. Not resting on their laurels, Sport Singapore's netballers are already looking ahead to their title defence - their prize money will be going towards court bookings.



The safety of members and guests in our swimming pools is of utmost importance. The Club conducts regular Lifeguard Refresher training courses for our team of lifeguards to keep them capable and responsive in rendering timely aid in times of emergencies.

On 7 November 2019, nine of our Clubhouse Lifeguards attended a half-day LG Refresher Training which ended in a test. All Lifeguards who took the test, passed.

#### **LG Refresher Training Curriculum**

The typical curriculum includes both theory and practical sessions:

- Case studies and sharing of recent incidents
- Silent drownings Sudden collapse while swimming due to hypoglycaemia (low sugar), epileptic seizure, shallow water black-outs
- Wet drowning? What is secondary or dry drowning?

The Practical session requires each clubhouse to present and/or conduct training on a given topic. At the 7 November training, these topics were covered:

- Rescue tube techniques (by Tessensohn Derick)
- Recovery and landing of casualty (by Changi Chang)
- 2 men Spinal board procedures (by Changi Chang)
- 2 men LG pit-crew rescue CPR / airbag / oxygen / AED (by Bukit Batok - Vishnu)
- In-water resuscitation before landing or while waiting for assistance to land casualty (by Changi – Chang)
- Fitness test (by Tessensohn Seng Yung)



#### Other Fitness & Test Requirements for Our Lifeguards



**Lifeguard Fitness Tests:** Lifeguards, who did not pass the fitness test, are required to retake the test monthly until they pass both items of the fitness test. Lifeguards need to re-do the monthly test until they pass to remain relevant for the job.

**Rescue EAP simulation:** The respective Clubhouse are required to conduct their own in-house Lifeguard Pit Crew Rescue training weekly on the co-ordination and use of rescue equipment – Air-Bag / Oxygen / AED / Casualty Recovery. This training record will be recorded and kept by Admin.





Weekly 2km swim: All Lifeguards are required to clock minimum distance of 2km swim weekly, to maintain their fitness.
