



## RULES & REGULATIONS

### **3RD TUESDAY SENIORS' SINGLES LEAGUE CHANGI RESORT BOWL, CSC @ CHANGI**

#### ELECTION COMMITTEE

An election shall be held to fill office of President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer prior to the commencement of the league, the elected committee shall decide on any dispute or protest and it is within its power to discipline any member for violating any provision of this constitution rules and regulations of this league.

#### COMPETITIVENESS

Each bowler will be going against one another based on a **Round Robin System**. Each bowler will earn points from 1 – 22 (based on 22 bowlers) based on game 1 – 4 and overall weekly positions. These are added to those of the total season score (24 weeks). There will be a Masters Event on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020, upon completion of the league.

#### MANAGEMENT

The Management of this league shall be vested in the league committee, which shall consist of the bowling league Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer and each representative captain of each team taking part in the league.

#### PLAYING RULES

This league is sanctioned by Singapore Bowling Federation, and league scores are eligible for house awards.

## HOUSE AWARDS & LEAGUE AWARDS

Roll-Off scores are not eligible for any individual / 300 perfect games or any other house & league award prizes.

### **300 PERFECT GAME:**

The bowler must inform the staff on duty when he/she has **eight (8) consecutive STRIKES**. Failing to do so will render the perfect game claim invalid. Perfect Game award will be shared amongst all qualifiers per calendar year.

All House Awards & 300 perfect game award is not valid until the League and Lane Sanction is validated. Masters Event are not eligible for the above.

**He/she must be a current member of S.B.F. affiliated club/associate member club.**

Non S.B.F. affiliated club current member will not be entitled of the House Award.

## BOWLERS

All bowlers are responsible for the eligibility, conduct and attendance of oneself. The bowler for each morning's bowling shall be responsible for the correctness of their own scores.

## LEAGUE FORMAT

- a. Handicap would be added on their 1<sup>st</sup> week of play.
- b. The Lane Assignments will be pre-drawn for the entire season, by the League Secretary before league commencement.
- c. 22<sup>nd</sup> position will get one (1) point and the champion for the week will get (22) points. (Based on 22 bowlers) Points will be consolidated from Game 1 -4, and overall (5 columns points system).
- d. All bowlers will bowl for a total of 24 weeks and Masters Event on week 25.
- e. Prizes will be based on Overall Individual Position Standing. There will also be prizes for High Game Scratch (Men & Ladies) and High Series Scratch (Men & Ladies).

## DURATION & STARTING TIME OF LEAGUE

The league will commence on 24<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and will continue for 24 weeks. All scheduled matches will start on every Tuesday promptly at **10:30am sharp**, Except on Public Holidays and the Eve of Public Holidays.

## GAMES FEE & TROPHY FUND

Games fee : \$ 10.00 (\$2.50 per game)

Trophy fund : \$ 4.00 per week

A total of **\$14.00** per bowler, per week. (Inclusive of Trophy Fund)

## WALKOVER

Bowlers will be awarded **0 points** in the event of no-show.

Points on weeks with walkovers bowlers will be tabulated based on total number of bowlers for the season from top down.

If the bowler walkover more than 4 times during the league season, the bowler will not qualify to win any prizes for the overall position season prize. Bowler will still be able to bowl for Masters.

## HANDICAPS

All bowlers will start with their 1<sup>st</sup> week handicap based on their 1<sup>st</sup> week of play.

Men Handicap will be calculated on the formula of base 180 – Average x 50%.

Maximum handicap for Men bowlers shall be 20.

Ladies Handicap will be calculated on the formula of base 195 – Average x 67%.

Maximum handicap for Ladies bowlers shall be 30.

Additional Handicaps will be given accordingly:

Deduction of handicaps will be given to the previous league winners accordingly:

1st	-5
2nd	-3
3rd	-2

### TARDY PLAYERS

A player who arrives after the game commences shall be permitted to begin bowling provided the last bowler of the lane does not complete the 3<sup>rd</sup> frame. **Player cannot join in after the 3<sup>rd</sup> frame. He/She may continue bowling the next 3 games.**

### SUBSTITUTE PLAYERS

Substitution of player during the game of the series will not be permitted.

### POSITION STANDINGS

Top 22 bowlers will be finalized at the end of 24 weeks.  
**Every bowler is entitled to a cash prize except walkover.**

### TIE IN POSITION

In the event of a tie occurring for the final standing of the league, **the higher scratch average will decide the individual standing position.**  
**If there is a tie again on scratch average, the total pin-falls will be the decider.**

### ROLL-OFF

There will be a **maximum of 12 Roll-Offs allowed** throughout the course of the season. Roll-off is at \$14.00 per attempt. **All bowlers are to keep at least 1 roll-off for emergency use, this is to prevent from holding off weekly scores.**  
**All roll-offs are also to be utilized before the end of the league.**

**No forfeiting of Roll-Off results, no carrying of roll-off results to the next season.**

In the event that bowler failed to turn up due to personal reasons and do not have any roll-off, **a grace period of rolling off within the next league day of the following week is permitted on a case to case basis.**

Bowlers are to inform the League Secretary for reservation of lanes for a suitable bowling day before the actual League commences. **Bowlers are not allowed to do a Roll-Off on Public Holidays.**

### INTERPRETATION AND ANY MATTER NOT PROVIDED FOR

The league committee shall rule upon all interpretation of this rules and regulations. Any matters not provided for shall be resolved by the league committee, in accordance to the general playing rules and regulations of SINGAPORE BOWLING FEDERATION.

## **PROTEST**

Any protest affecting eligibility on general play rules must be confirmed in writing to the league secretary not later than three (3) days after the series in which the infraction occurred. If no written protest is entered prior to the expiration of the three (3) days period, the series must stand as bowled. Protest resulting out of competition on the concluding days of a league's schedule must be filed within 48 hours thereafter. All protest to be made immediately to a league official.

## **DISABILITY, INJURY, EMERGENCY, ETC**

When a player is unable to complete a game because of disability, injury, emergency, etc, bowlers shall count his scores for the frames in the game(s) or use the blind scores, whichever higher will apply.

## **MASTER'S EVENT**

Master's Finals Event is scheduled on Tuesday, 8<sup>th</sup> September 2020.

Check In: 10am

Roll-Off: 10.30am sharp.

\$50.00 per Entry, 6 Games Series.

All bowlers are entitled to bowl for the Masters.

### **Lane Change**

2 pairs of lanes to the right

### **Handicaps for Masters Event**

Prevailing handicap at week 24 applies.

**Maximum handicap for Men bowlers shall be 10.**

**Maximum handicap for Ladies bowlers shall be 20.**
