EVENT DETAILS

1 **Eligibility**

- 1.1 The bell boating and kayaking try-outs are open to all civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, Civil Service Club (CSC) members and employees of registered former Statutory Board.
- 1.2 Public Officers and Civil Service Club members must pre-register themselves and their spouses, children and/or parents for the event.

2 Public Service Sports And Family Day (PSSFD) Tickets

- 2.1 Public Officers and Civil Service Club members must be pre-registered to take part in the activities at the PSSFD. They can register their spouses, children and/or parents, up to a maximum of six (6) persons, for the event.
- 2.2 Only registered participants and family members will be issued with the PSSFD tickets for redemption of fun packs and freebies at the event.
- 2.3 Each participant or family member shall be issued with only <u>one</u> PSSFD ticket regardless of the number of events participating in.
- 2.4 Participants shall collect the PSSFD tickets from the liaison officers of their respective agencies.
- 2.5 Participants must bring along their tickets on day of event as <u>no replacement</u> tickets will be issued at the event.

3 Bell Boating Try Out

- The bell boat try-out shall commence only after the dragon boat race, at about 10.00am. Participating groups shall be advised on the timing to report.
- 3.2 Participants must be at least 12 years of age as of 20 July 2019.
- 3.3 Participants must be able to swim.
- 3.4 Each group shall comprise a minimum of six and a maximum of eight rowers.
- 3.5 Participating groups must report punctually to the officials at PA Water-Venture
- 3.6 Registration will stop at 12pm and all activities will cease at 1pm.
- 3.7 A maximum of 30 participants is allowed in each activity time slot. The activity time slots are 10 am 11am; 11 am 12pm and 12 pm 1pm.

4 Kayaking Try-Out

- 4.1 Kayaking try-out shall commence only after the dragon boat race, at about 10.00am. Participating groups shall be advised on the timing to report.
- 4.2 Participants must be at least 12 years of age as of 20 July 2019.
- 4.3 Participants under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult (above 21 years of age).
- 4.4 Participants must be able to swim.
- 4.5 Registration will stop at 12pm and all activities will cease at 1pm.

4.6 A maximum of 20 participants is allowed in each activity time slot. The activity time slots are as 10 am – 11am; 11 am – 12pm and 12 pm – 1pm.

5 Food

5.1 No food is allowed in the Marina Channel.

6 Safety and Inclement Weather

- 6.1 It is <u>compulsory</u> for all participants to wear buoyancy vest.
- 6.2 All water sport activities will either be delayed or cancelled if there is a lightning alert or inclement weather.

7 Attire

7.1 Participants must be prepared to get wet. They are advised to bring along a spare set of attires.

8 Fun Packs

8.1 Fun Packs and other freebies can only be collected at about 9.30am.
