RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Event

- 1.1 The Public Service Amazing Race (Amazing Race) will be held in conjunction with the Public Service Sports and Family Day 2019.
- 1.2 Participation is free.

2. Eligibility

2.1 The Amazing Race is open only to civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, and employees of registered former Statutory Boards.

3. Entry and Registration

3.1 Only team registration shall be accepted. Teams must register through the Sports Liaison Officers/Co-ordinator of their respective organisations via the online portal. <u>Individual entries will not be accepted</u>.

- 3.2 Each agency is allowed to enter a maximum of five teams. All the team members must be Public Officers.
- 3.3 Each team shall comprise a minimum of 5 and maximum of 6 members.
- 3.4 A team must include at least one female player.
- 3.5 An agency is allowed to register players from other government agencies. The agency registering a mixed-agency team must ensure that all the team members are eligible players.
- 3.6 Team members must produce their staff cards and Identity Card when called upon or in event of protest. Teams fielding ineligible players shall be disqualified from the event.
- 3.7 Only registered participants and accompanying family members will be issued with PSSFD tickets for redemption of fun packs and freebies at the event. They must bring along their tickets on day of event as no replacement cards will be issued at the event.

4. Game Rules

- 4.1 Before the start of the race, one player from each team will download the game app on his or her mobile device.
- 4.2 Teams are to navigate using the game app to locate the "hotspots".
- 4.3 Players can complete the hotspots in any order they choose. They are not required to visit all hotspots.
- 4.4 Challenges are unlocked when teams arrive at the hotspots. Points will be awarded based on completion of the challenges.
- 4.5 The <u>absolute cut-off time</u> for teams to reach the ending point at Gardens By the Bay (Bay East) is <u>11.30am</u> after which no scoring will be done. Teams must plan their routes carefully.
- 4.6 Only public transport (bus or train) and walking are the only means of travel permitted in the Public Service Amazing Race (unless otherwise specified).
- 4.7 All the team members must be together when attempting the challenges.
- 4.8 Points will be deducted from the team that found to be taking personal vehicles or all forms of taxi.

5 Prizes

5.1 The top four teams with most points shall be awarded the following cash prizes.

5.2 Team Captains must be present to collect the prizes from the Guest-of- Honour otherwise the prizes will be forfeited.

6. Safety

- 6.1 All participants will be given 1 bottle of water and MUST carry hydration (water, isotonic drink or other fluids) in form of a hydration belt, bag or bottle throughout the race.
- 6.2 For the safety of participants, all players are advised to walk / run on the designated path throughout the route.
- 6.3 Participants who require immediate medical attention may call the Public Service Amazing Race emergency hotline.

7. Wet Weather Programme

- 7.1 The Public Service Amazing Race will still proceed in event of wet weather.
- 7.2 Participants will be given ponchos and are advised to bring along spare set of sports attire and umbrellas in case of wet weather.

8. <u>Organisation T-shirt</u>

8.1 Participants in a team are encouraged to wear their organisation's T-shirt or T-shirt of the similar colour if they do not have an organisation T-shirt. This is to facilitate easy identification of the team members.

9. Baggage and Accessories

- 9.1 There are no baggage deposit at the starting point. Participants are advised to travel light.
- 9.2 Teams must ensure that they have enough portable chargers
- 9.3 Teams must ensure that they have enough credits in their Ezlink card.

10. Protest

- 10.1 Any protest must be submitted:
 - a) by the Team Manager/Captain,
 - b) in writing using the official Protest Form,

- c) to the Organiser,
- d) together with a deposit of \$50, and
- e) within 10 minutes following the conclusion of the Public Service Amazing Race in dispute.
- 10.2 The Protest Committee shall comprise a staff from Civil Service Club and two Sports Liaison Officers/Team Captains not involved in the dispute.
- 10.3 The decision of the Protest Committee in any dispute is final and no correspondence will be entertained.
- 10.4 The whole team will be disqualified if any of its members confront any official or staff of the Organisers.

11 Rights

- 11.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to revise the format, rules and regulations as and when deemed appropriate.
- 11.2 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the venue, date and/or time of the event at its discretion due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen circumstances.

12 **Indemnity**

- 12.1 Participants take part in the event at their own risk.
- 12.2 The Civil Service Club, the Organising Committee, appointed contractors, sponsors, appointed officials and staff shall not be responsible for any mishap, injury or loss of life that may be suffered by participants and/or supporters before, during or after the event.
- 12.3 The Civil Service Club, the Organising Committee, appointed contractors, sponsors, appointed officials and staff shall not be responsible for any loss of personal belongings.
