REGISTRATION INFORMATION

1 Eligibility

- 1.1 The Public Service Sports and Family Day (PSSFD) is open to all civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, Civil Service Club members and employees of registered former Statutory Boards.
- 1.2 Public Service Officers and Civil Service Club members may register their family members to take part in designated activities at the event.
- 1.3 Participation is free.
- 1.4 The rules and regulations for specific activities apply.

2. Definition

- 2.1 "Public Service Officers" (PSOs) refer to all civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, Civil Service Club members and employees of registered former Statutory Boards.
- 2.3 CSC members refer to valid members of the Civil Service Club.
- 2.4 "Family Members" refer to their spouse, children, parents and siblings.

3 Online Registration

- 3.1 PSOs including those taking part in Olympic Walk, CSC Cycle and Inter-Agency Team Sports, need to register themselves and their family members if attending, to obtain the PSSFD QR code for check-in and redemption of goody bags/freebies at the event. Registration will be accepted if they sign-up using their **office email**.
- 3.2 CSC members who are not public service officers, can register themselves at <https://www.csc.sg/events/EventsDetail/1505/PSSFD---Freebies--amp--Goodie-Bags-Registration> and their family members to take in the Olympic Walk, Sports try-out and Carnival activities.
- 3.3 Each PSO is allowed to register a family of maximum 5 members (including the Public Service officer).
- 3.4 Only one QR code will be emailed to the PSO (registrant) regardless of the number of family members registered. The same QR code will be scanned for redemption of goodie bags/freebies by family members.
- 3.5 The PSSFD QR code need to be downloaded and presented either in a screen grab, printed format or on mobile devices, at the check-in and redemption booths, and for participation in the carnival activities.
- 3.6 The quantity of goodie bags / freebies issued will be based on the actual number of registered pax present at the counter. There shall be no collection on behalf.
- 3.7 PSOs are advised to check their inbox, spam or junk folder for the PSSFD QR code.
- 3.8 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to invalidate the QR code if the applicant is found to be ineligible to participate or if a duplicate registration is discovered.

4 Goodie Bags

- 4.1 Goodie bags and items are based on "while stocks last".
- 4.2 Redemption of goodie bags shall start after the Olympic Walk, at about 9.30am.

- 4.3 Participants can redeem goodie bags by showing the QR code at the Goodie Bag Redemption Booth.
- 4.3 The quantity of goodie bags / freebies issued will be based on the actual number of registered pax present at the redemption booth. There shall be no collection on behalf.

5 Lucky Draw

- 5.1 The Lucky Draw Booth shall be open at about 11.30am or at time to be advised, for deposit of lucky coupons.
- 5.2 There will be 50 lucky draw prizes.
- 5.3 The top prize is 3-Nights Balcony Stateroom for 4 persons onboard Dream Cruise (worth \$4,497).
- 5.4 The 4th to 50th prizes will be drawn before the Prize-Giving Ceremony. The winning ticket numbers will be displayed on two display boards. All prizes must be collected by 1pm on the day of the Carnival otherwise they will be forfeited.
- 5.5 The 1st to 3rd prizes will be drawn on stage after the Prize-Giving Ceremony. Prize winners are required to claim their prize personally. If the prize is not claimed when the ticket winning number is called, it will be re-draw and given to the next name drawn.

6 Personal Data Protection

- 6.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.

7 Covid-19 Safe Management Measures

- 7.1 All participating agencies and teams must comply with prevailing COVID-19 Safe Management Measures issued by Ministry of Health and Sport Singapore.
- 7.2 Participants are advised to exercise social responsibility. They must not show up at the event if feeling unwell or exhibit any symptoms of Covid-19 infections.
