Note:

- Championship positions will be based on the points obtained from the best <u>seven games for Div I organisations</u> and best <u>five games for Div II organisations</u> out of the 18 games.
- 2) Championship points will be awarded only if there are at least 8 organisations participating in a championship game.
- 3) Championship points will be awarded to the top division eg. if the game has 4 divisions, only the results of the top division will count for points.
- 4) If the game has 2 or more categories (eg. Men's Veteran) the results of all the categories will be used to determine the award of points.
- If two organisations are tied in any of the top 4 positions, the championship points of that positions and the next lower position will be added and shared equally amongst them.

Tie-Breakers

- a) 1st tie-breaker: Highest number of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placings won in that order by the organisations.
- b) 2nd tie-breakers: Most number of championship games participated in.
- c) 3rd tie-breakers: Most number of non-championship games participated in.
