

BYE-LAWS OF CUESPORTS SINGAPORE NATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE (CSA)

A GENERAL

1. All equipment in the Billiards Room belongs to Cuesports Singapore (CS). Members are to exercise care to all equipment to avoid damage and unnecessary wear and tear.
2. Game etiquettes must be observed at all times. Unnecessary noise and/or disturbances to other players must be avoided.
3. Offensive language is to be avoided.
4. Coloured balls must be placed in the respective spots on the Billiards and Pool table to avoid damage to the tablecloth. Balls should be rolled into position gently.
5. Members are responsible for any damage they cause and will bear the costs of repair and/or replacement. Damages such as, but not limited to, causing tear on the table cloth, damage of CS equipment, spilling liquid on the table cloth, damage to the rail of the table and furniture in the training centre ect.
6. Chalk which belongs to Cuesports Singapore must not be removed from the premises.
7. Pool and Snooker balls must not be thrown or dropped into the wooden triangle when racking. The balls should be placed gently and neatly by hand, and the wooden triangle placed over the balls.
8. Sitting on the pool or snooker table is prohibited.
9. Placing any liquid or food, or container containing the same, on the pool or snooker table is prohibited.
10. Smoking and vaping on the entire premises, including but not limited to, Cuesports Singapore National Training Centre, is strictly prohibited.
11. Gambling on the premises is strictly prohibited.
12. Consumption of alcohol in the premises is strictly prohibited.
13. No entry and play in the Billiards and Pool Room for students in school uniform.
14. Cuesports Singapore has the right to remove or restrict the privileges of any person/s who are found in breach of these rules and regulations, including exclusion from the premises.

B ATTIRE / EQUIPMENT

15. Acceptable Attire (Save for tournaments, where attire will follow tournament regulations):
 - Clean, dry shirts or collarless T-shirts
 - Shoes or Sandals with covered toes
 - Long Pants or Bermudas
16. Unacceptable Attire:
 - Running shorts
 - Singlets
 - Spiked shoes or Flip Flops
 - Offensive tops and/or bottoms
 - School uniform
