RULES & REGULATIONS

1 RULES OF THE GAME

- 1.1 The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Federation Internationale de Volleyball (FIVB), STAR Games General Rules, and Tournament Rules.

2 ENTRY AND REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- 2.1 The Tournament is open to all civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools, and invited former Statutory Boards.
- 2.2 The tournament shall comprise the Men and Women's categories.
- 2.3 Sports Liaison Officers can register their players online at www.csc.sg/stargames.

- 2.4 Registration must be accompanied by online payment of the registration fee otherwise it will be voided.
- 2.5 For organisations that have entered more than one team, the substitution of players from registered players of the teams will not be allowed after the draw. Substituting of players must be from players not originally registered. Switching of players between the teams will also not be permitted.
- 2.6 An organisation is allowed to register a maximum of twelve (12) players for each team and a minimum of eight (8) players (inclusive of a team manager) per team.
- 2.7 A player is allowed to register and play for one team only.
- 2.8 Each team must have at least six (6) players (excluding a Libero player) on the court before the game can be started.
- 2.9 Any changes to the online Registration Form must be made two (2) days before the tournament. No changes will be allowed on the day of the event unless there are valid reasons. A player who has left the government service on the day of play shall not be eligible to participate but another player may be registered in his or her place.

3 SYSTEM OF PLAY

- 3.1 The tournament shall run on a Double Knock-out system. The match shall be played based on one (1) set of 25 points without deuce for both, the Women's Category and Men's Category for preliminary rounds. The **final** shall be played based on **one (1) set of 25 points with minimum lead of 2 points** for both categories.

4 DRAW

- 4.1 The system of drawing shall be as follows:
 - a) The top four teams of last year's tournament shall be seeded and placed into different groups. The placing of the four teams shall be pre-determined by the Organiser.
 - b) For agencies with more than one team, the teams from the same agency shall be drawn into different groupings first.
 - c) After completion of (b), the rest of the teams shall then be drawn into the different groups.

5 UMPIRES/OFFICIALS

- 5.1 The Organisers may engage referees and umpires from the Volleyball Association of Singapore to officiate the tournament. The participating teams shall provide linesmen for their matches.

6 JERSEY

- 6.1 Members of a team should wear similar jerseys. The numbers (ranging from 1 to 99) must be clearly displayed on the front and back of the jerseys.

7 HEIGHT OF NETS

- 7.1 The height of the net for the Men's category will be 2.43 m.
- 7.2 The height of the net for the Women's category will be 2.24 m.

8 PHOTOGRAPHY

- 8.1 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of Participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of any STAR Games, for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising and distribution to sponsors and partners.
- 8.2 Photography and/or videography will be taken during the event for news and publicity purposes by the official photographer and/or videographer, and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms of the Civil Service Club. The Organiser owns all rights to the photographs and video recordings. Any participants who do not wish to have their photographs or video recordings taken can notify inform the Organiser at the event site.

9 PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

- 9.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.
