RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1.1 The Competition is open to civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals, Government-Aided Schools and registered former Statutory Boards.
- 1.2 Players must have an MLBB account that fulfills the following criteria:
 - a) Level 8 or above
 - b) Owns at least 10 heroes
- 1.3 This tournament is only open to players based in Singapore.

2 **ENTRY & REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS**

- 2.1 Registration must be submitted through the Sports Liaison Officer of the Ministry/organisation.
- 2.2 Registration must be accompanied by online payment of registration fee otherwise, it will be void. There shall be no refund of registration fees.

- 2.3 E-Sports Convenors from the respective agencies would be administrator for the tournament channel via Discord and must add their team members into the channel using a link for participants to join in.
- 2.4 E-Sports Convenors must ensure that the mobile phone numbers of each registered participant/s must belong to the registered participant and not belong to another person.
- 2.5 E-Sports Convenors must email details on their team members using the form provided to desmondho@csc.sg. Details required will be as follows:
 - a) Name
 - b) Email address
 - c) Organisation
 - d) Mobile number

3 FORMAT

- 3.1 This tournament will be played online on Mobile phone / Tablets.
- 3.2 The Competition is for teams based on Single Elimination, best of 3.
- 3.3 Players will be provided with a Discord Channel for reporting upon closure of Tournament registration.

4 PLAYER REPORTING

4.1 Discord and communications

- a) A Discord channel will be provided for players for tournament use. All information and communication will be **through Discord only**.
- b) Discord link will be provided after registration has ended.

4.2 Pre-Game Reporting

- a) Players should report on Discord **at least 15 minutes** before the event start time for each day.
- b) Players who are late will be disqualified.

4.1 Post-Match Reporting

- a) All teams are required to post their match scores in the discord channel through a screenshot or a photo taken from their mobile devices.
- b) Any teams whom have failed to report matches will be subject to confirmation from both teams and disputes will be resolved accordingly.

5 **TOURNAMENT SETTINGS AND RULES**

5.1 Players will be required to set up their own matches after briefing by the tournament administrator.

5.2 Tournament rules:

- a) Tournament will be played online.
- b) Tablets are allowed.
- c) No emulator and third-party programs/peripherals allowed.
- d) New heroes released within 2 weeks prior to the tournament will be banned.

5.3 The Match Settings shall be Custom draft pick.

6 **PRIZES**

6.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 4 teams in the tournament as follows:

4th Place	Cash Prize \$100 and 5 Medals
