## RULES & REGULATIONS

### 1 **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1.1 The Tournament is open to all civil servants and officers serving in Statutory Boards, Restructured Hospitals and Government-Aided Schools.
- 1.2 The following officers (including non-resident officers) shall not be eligible to participate in the STAR Games:
  - a) Public Officers who have represented Singapore (including those as Reserves) or their respective countries (for non-resident officers) in SEA Games, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games or Olympic Games during the current year and past two years,
  - b) Players who earn their living as professional players for Clubs, etc during the current and past two years, and
  - c) Full-time National Servicemen

### 2 **REGISTRATION**

- 2.1 Sports Liaison Officers can register their teams online at <https://www.csc.sg/stargames>. All registration must be accompanied by online payment of registration fee otherwise it will be void.
- 2.2 An agency is allowed to register any number of teams but they must submit the registration online before the closing date. Registered teams are not allowed to switch players.

- 2.3 Each team shall comprise of 10 players. A team must always have 5 players and minimum 2 female players on the field.
- 2.4 An agency is allowed to register players from other government agencies. The agency registering the mixed-agency team must ensure that all the team members are eligible players.
- 2.5 A player is allowed to play for one agency only. Multiple representation of agencies by a player is strictly not allowed.

### **3 REPORTING**

- 3.1 Team Captains must register their teams' presence with the tournament official at least **30 minutes** before their first match on day of the event.
- 3.2 Teams must report punctually to the umpires at their designated court for their matches. Late reporting may result in disqualification of the team.
- 3.3 No match may start unless each team has at least five players on the scheduled court. In the event that any team being unable to field the minimum number of five players within 1 minute of starting time, that is 1 minute grace period, the umpires shall give a walkover against such team that has less than five players.

### **4 FORMAT**

- 4.1 The format of the Competition shall be as follows:
  - a) The competition shall be played using Round Robin format in their respective groups.
  - b) Each team shall comprise of ten (10) players, with five (5) players playing at all times.
  - c) There must be at least two (2) female players on the field at all times.
  - d) Playing time for all games will be 2 periods of 10 minutes each, with 2-minute interval between each period. Central timing will be provided.
  - e) The score cap will be at nine (9).
  - f) At the end of 20 minutes, finish the point. Any team that is leading wins the game. If it is a draw, play universe point. There shall be no draws for any games.
  - g) Substitution of players can only be made after the point is scored or to substitute an injured player.
  - h) All teams must be ready at the designated courts to start the games promptly. A team must have a minimum of 5 players on the field before a game can

start otherwise that team shall concede a walkover to the opponent team. A 7-0 result will be awarded to the other team should a walkover happens.

- i) Should there be a tie of points after completion of the Round Robin matches, the winning team be determined by the following sequence:
  - 1) win-loss
  - 2) head-to-head
  - 3) goal difference and
  - 4) points scored.
- j) Top 2 teams from each group will qualify for the semi-finals.
- k) The winners of semi-finals will play in the final to determine the first and second placing, while the losers of each semi-final will play for third and fourth placing.

## 5 **ATTIRE**

- 5.1 No bare bodies are allowed of either gender in the competition and players are to bring their own jersey and tops. It is advisable to bring 2 sets in the event that colour clashes.
- 5.2 When the jersey colours of two teams are similar, both teams representatives are to conduct a disc-toss before the game to decide on who will change their jerseys/bibs to a different colour.
- 5.3 Players must not wear jewelleries, watches or fancy rings. If wedding rings are worn, they must be taped.

## 6 **PROTEST**

- 6.1 All players are advised to adhere to game rules, tournament rules and referees' decisions. The committee and referees will only handle disputes brought forward by the captains. No protests from players other than the captain will be entertained.
- 6.2 In cases of protest, the Protest Committee shall comprise one CSC staff and two captains of teams not involved in the protest incident. The Committee's decision is final.

## 7 **ORGANISATION OF THE GAME**

- 7.1 The clock will not stop in event of injuries or any stoppages.

## 8 **PHOTOGRAPHY**

- 8.1 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of Participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of any STAR Games, for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising and distribution to sponsors and partners. 19.2 Photography and/or videography will be taken during the event for news and publicity purposes by the official photographer and/or videographer, and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms of the Civil Service Club. The Organiser owns all rights to the photographs and video recordings. Any participants who do not wish to have their photographs or video recordings taken can notify inform the Organiser at the event site.

## 9 **PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION**

- 9.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.

## 10 **COVID-19 SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES**

- 10.1 All participating agencies and teams must comply with prevailing COVID-19 Safe Management Measures (SMMs) issued by Ministry of Health and Sport Singapore.
- 10.2 Game convenors and team managers / captains are responsible to ensure that their team members comply with prevailing SMMs and safety protocols as laid down by the Organiser and venue owners, including the following:
- a) Participants must be fully vaccinated.
  - b) Team members are strongly encouraged to self-administer ART before reporting at the event venues.
  - c) Team members must exercise social responsibility and not show up at the event venues if they are not feeling well or exhibit any symptoms of Covid-19 infections.

The Civil Service Club reserves the right to cancel, postpone or change the venue, date and/or time of the competition at its discretion due to inclement weather, facility problem or any other situation deemed as appropriate.
