RULES & REGULATIONS

1 RULES OF THE GAME

- 1.1 The existing Rules & Regulations used by the Volleyball Association of Singapore (VAS) will be adopted in the Tournament except that there will not be any front or back row classification. Each player must take turn to serve.

2 REGISTRATION

- 2.1 Sports Liaison Officers can register their players online at www.csc.sg/stargames .
- 2.2 Registration must be accompanied by online payment of registration fee otherwise it will be void.
- 2.3 An agency is allowed to register players from other government agencies. The agency registering the mixed-agency team must ensure that all the team members are eligible players.
- 2.4 A player is allowed to play for one agency only. Multiple representation of agencies by a player is strictly not allowed.

- 2.5 Organisations which entered more than two teams are not allowed to switch registered players among their teams after the draw. Substituting of players must be from players not originally registered.
- 2.6 A team must register a minimum 4 players and a maximum of 6 players. A team must field in a minimum of 3 players in order to start the game.
- 2.7 Any changes to the Registration Form must be submitted to the officials 30 minutes before the first match. No changes will be allowed after submission of the list unless the Committee does not approve a player. A player who has left government service on the day of play shall not be eligible to participate but another player may be registered in his or her place.

3 **FORMAT**

- 3.1 All matches shall be played based on one (1) set of 21 points with no change of service and deuce. At 20 all the team that gains a 2-point lead first, wins the match. The Ping-pong system of service shall be used.
- 3.2 The tournament shall comprise two categories, namely -
 - i) Men's Category
 - ii) Women's Category
- 3.3 The format of the Tournament shall be as follows:
 - a) In the preliminary round, teams will play a round-robin format in their respective groups.
 - b) Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 point for a loss.
 - c) Teams with equal points at the end of the round robin, will be placed according to
 - i. head-to-head results
 - ii. goal difference (i.e. difference between goals for and goals against)
 - iii. no. of points scored
 - d) The top two of each group shall proceed to play in the knock-out stage.
 - e) The winners of semi-finals will play in the final to determine the first and second placing, while the losers of semi-finals will play for third and fourth placing.
 - f) The winners of each semi-final will play in the final to determine the first and second placing, while the losers of each semi-final will play for the third and fourth placing.
 - g) There will be two time-outs for any match and no substitution is allowed during the play unless a player is injured. The injured player will not be allowed to re-enter to play the remaining of the set.

4 PRIZES

- 4.1 Cash Prizes and medals will be awarded to the top 4 teams of each category.
- 4.2 A trophy shall be awarded to the Overall Champion.

5 HEIGHT OF NET

- 5.1 The height of the net will be as follows:
 - i) For Men's Category – 2.43 meters
 - ii) For Women's Category – 2.24 meters

6 ATTIRE

- 6.1 Players of each team shall wear numbered jerseys of the same colour.
- 6.2 Bare body is not allowed.

7 CONDUCT OF THE GAMES

- 7.1 The Organisers reserves the right to change the format or timings of the games if deemed necessary. The results of all completed games shall stand. There will be a re-play for all incomplete games

8 PHOTOGRAPHY

- 8.1 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of Participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of any STAR Games, for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising and distribution to sponsors and partners.
- 8.2 Photography and/or videography will be taken during the event for news and publicity purposes by the official photographer and/or videographer, and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms of the Civil Service Club. The Organiser owns all rights to the photographs and video recordings. Any participants who do not wish to have their photographs or video recordings taken can notify inform the Organiser at the event site.

9 PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

- 9.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.
