RULES & REGULATIONS

1 THE TOURNAMENT

- 1.1 The Public Service 3-On-3 Mixed Floorball Tournament 2023 shall be conducted in accordance with the IFF 2022 Rules of the Game, STAR Games General Rules and Tournament Rules laid down below.
- 1.2 The tournament is a Championship STAR Games subject to a minimum of eight (8) participating agencies.

2 ENTRY AND REGISTRATION

- 2.1 Sports Liaison Officers can register their teams and players online at www.csc.sg/stargames.
- 2.2 Registration must be accompanied by online payment of registration fee otherwise it will be void.

- 2.3 An agency's team shall comprise only staff of the agency.
- 2.4 Team Managers/Captains must ensure that the list of registered players and their particulars given in the online registration portal are updated two days before commencement date of the tournament. No changes to the list of registered players shall be allowed on first day of event unless there are valid reasons.
- 2.5 Agencies fielding more than one team, are not allowed to substitute players from another team after the draw is made. Substituting of players must be from players not originally registered. Switching of players between the teams will also not be permitted.
- 2.6 Pregnant ladies are not allowed to play in the tournament and if found playing with the knowledge of the team, the team shall be disqualified.
- 2.7 Each team shall comprise of 5 players (3 players and 2 reserves). A player is allowed to register and play for one team only.
- 2.8 A player who has left the government service on the day of play shall not be eligible to participate but another player may be registered in his or her place.

3 SYSTEM OF DRAW

- 3.1 Draw for the fixtures shall be conducted after closing date. The system of draw shall be as follow:
- a) The teams from an agency fielding more than one team, shall be drawn into different groups first.
 - b) After completion of (a), the rest of the teams shall then be drawn into the different groups.

4 REPORTING

- 4.1 All participating teams must be present at least **30 minutes** before their first match on day of the tournament. Team Captains must register their teams' presence with the tournament officials.
- 4.2 Teams must report punctually to the umpires at their designated court for their matches. Late reporting may result in disqualification of the team.
- 4.3 No match may start unless each team has at least three players on the scheduled court. In the event that any team being unable to field the minimum

number of three players within 1 minute of starting time, that is 1-minute grace period, the umpires shall give a walkover against such team that has less than three players. Penalty for walkover will be 5-0 score line, in favour to the team that adhere to the tournament rules.

5 FORMAT AND ORGANISATION OF PLAY

- 5.1 In the preliminary round, teams will play a round robin format in their respective groups. Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 point for a loss. Teams with equal points on completion of the round-robin round, will be placed in the following order:
- a) goal scored
 - b) head-to-head
 - c) goal different
- 5.2 Top teams from each group will qualify for the knock-out round.
- 5.3 The winners of semi-finals will play in the final to determine the first and second placing, while the losers of each semi-final will play for third and fourth placing.
- 5.4 If a match in the knock-out round ends in a draw, a penalty shootout will occur. 3 penalty shots will be given and the higher scoring team will proceed.
- 5.5 If a match in the semi-final or finals ends in a draw, extra 5 minutes of game time with a 1-minute interval at full time. The game will be decided via golden goal and the team who score first will be declared the winner. However if the score line remains as a draw, the fore-mention point of penalty shoot out will be enforced.
- 5.6 Playing time for all games will be 2 periods of 5 minutes each, with 1 minute interval.
- 5.7 Substitution of players can be made anytime throughout the game.
- 5.8 There must be at least 1 female and 1 male player on court at any one time.
- 5.9 All teams must be ready at the designated courts to start the games promptly. A team must have a minimum of 3 players on the court before a game can start otherwise that team shall concede a walkover to the opponent team.

6 ATTIRE

- 6.1 Teams are advised to bring 2 sets of jerseys in case of colour clashes. No bare bodies are allowed in the tournament.

- 6.2 When the colours of two teams are similar, the first named team in the fixtures shall change their bibs to a different colour.
- 6.3 Players must not wear jewellery, watches or fancy rings. If wedding rings are worn, they must be taped.

7 DISCIPLINE

- 7.1 In cases of misconduct or disciplinary offence, the Disciplinary Committee shall meet to consider any report made to them as soon as possible and in any case, not later than ten days after the submission of the report, alleging such misconduct or disciplinary offence
- 7.2 All players are advised to adhere to game rules, tournament rules and referees' decisions. The committee and referees will only handle disputes brought forward by the captains. No protests from players other than the captain will be entertained.
- 7.3 Any team that cause a game to be abandoned by walking out shall be liable for disciplinary action.

8 PHOTOGRAPHY

- 8.1 The Civil Service Club reserves the right to use any photographs (including those of Participants), motion pictures, recordings, or any other media records of any STAR Games, for any legitimate purpose, including commercial advertising and distribution to sponsors and partners.
- 8.2 Photography and/or videography will be taken during the event for news and publicity purposes by the official photographer and/or videographer, and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms of the Civil Service Club. The Organiser owns all rights to the photographs and video recordings. Any participants who do not wish to have their photographs or video recordings taken can notify inform the Organiser at the event site.

9 PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

- 9.1 All participants consent to their personal data being collected and processed for purposes of administration and communication in a particular event. Participants also agree to receive postings on other events organised by the Civil Service Club.
